Collection

When you come to collect, please make sure you have something to transport them in. A dog crate with an old towel is ideal. A cardboard box can work too if it has plenty of air holes. Unfortunately, we do not have boxes available for this purpose so please ensure you have something suitable with you and that it is big enough.

Health

Ducks will have been health checked and any issues will be shared with you if known. If you notice any problems, please let us know and we can advise.
