Your gutters play a bigger role in protecting your home than most people realize. When they're clean and working properly, they quietly move thousands of gallons of water away from your roof, siding, and foundation. 1. Prevents Water Damage

Clogged gutters overflow, sending water down your siding and into places it shouldn't be. Over time, this leads to:

- Rotting fascia boards
- Damaged siding
- Interior leaks
- Mold growth

When water pools around the base of your home, it can:

- Crack your foundation
- Cause basement leaks
- Lead to shifting or settling

Healthy gutters move water safely away from your home's structure.
