

# UNDERSTANDING YOUR HOME'S GUTTER SYSTEM

## *Quick Homeowner Guide*

A gutter system is more than just gutters. Each part works together to move water safely away from your home. Here's a simple breakdown of the components and what they do.

### **Gutters**

Collect rainwater from the roof and channel it toward the downspouts.

### **Downspouts**

Vertical pipes that carry water from the gutters down to the ground.

### **Elbows**

Angled pieces that guide water around corners or direct it away from the home.

### **Hangers & Brackets**

Support the gutters and keep them securely attached to the fascia.

### **End Caps**

Seal the ends of the gutters to prevent leaks.

### **Gutter Guards (Optional)**

Help keep debris out and reduce the frequency of cleanings.

### **Extensions & Splash Blocks**

Move water 4–6 feet away from the foundation to prevent pooling and erosion.

### **Why It Matters**

A properly functioning gutter system protects your roof, siding, foundation, and landscaping from water damage.
