We are proud to be a part of and serve such a great community. 2022 was yet again a busy year with a total of 1,721 calls, very similar to 2021. We continue to see a significant number of responses to surrounding communities (mutual aid). Our mutual aid responses are up 57% over 2021 and up 119% over the 5 year running average. We provided mutual aid 206 times this year and we required mutual aid 87 times.
