## CUTTING

## Fabric A

(4) $8.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof (width of fabric)
(20) $8.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Take extra care to cut 5 blocks from each strip.

## Fabric B

(13) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof (width of fabric)

Set aside 3 strips for a scrappy binding.
From EACH of the remaining 10 strips cut
(1) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ (for an over all total of 10)
(2) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ (for an over all total of 20 )
(1) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$ (for an over all total of 10 )

## Fabric C

(13) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof (width of fabric)

Set aside 3 strips for a scrappy binding.
From EACH of the remaining 10 strips cut
(1) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ (for an over all total of 10)
(2) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ (for an over all total of 20)
(1) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$ (for an over all total of 10 )

## ASSEMBLY

Sew a $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5$ " fabric ' $B$ ' rectangle to one side of a $8.5^{\prime \prime}$ focal fabric ' $A$ ' square and press outwards.
Sew a 2.5 " $\times 10.5$ " fabric ' $B$ ' rectangle to an adjacent side of previously sewn strip and press outwards.
Sew a 2.5 " $\times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ fabric ' $C$ ' rectangle to side of quilt block, as pictured and press outwards.
Sew a 2.5" × 12.5" fabric 'C' rectangle to the adjacent side, as pictured) and press outwards. Make 10 identical ' $B$ " Blocks.


Sew a 2.5 " $\times 8.5$ " fabric ' $C$ ' rectangle to one side of a 8.5 " focal fabric ' $A$ ' square and press outwards.
Sew a 2.5 " $\times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ fabric ' $C$ ' rectangle to an adjacent side of previously sewn strip and press outwards.
Sew a 2.5 " $\times 10.5$ " fabric 'B' rectangle to side of quilt block, as pictured and press outwards.
Sew a 2.5 " $\times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$ fabric ' $B$ ' rectangle to the adjacent side, as pictured) and press outwards. Make 10 identical 'C' Blocks.

Alternating blocks, sew (2) 'B' blocks together with 2 ' C' blocks in a row pressing towards ' $B$ ' blocks. Using diagrams as a guide pay extra attention to block positions. Make 5 identical rows.

Sew rows together flipping rows 2 and 4 end to end, pressing open.


For a scrappier binding, you may choose to cut a few strips 21" long. Sew binding strips together end to end on the diagonal, remove excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.

Layer with batting and backing, quilt as desired, bind and enjoy!
