Appalachian Autumn Table Topper

Supply List:

- -3/4" to 2" scrap strips to make 12 5-inch string blocks in autumn colors
- -approx. 3/8-yard scrap fabric in lighter greys for background
- -approx. 3/8-yard scrap fabric in creams/neutrals for background; small prints are fine
- -approx. ½-yard variety scrap fabrics in yellow, orange, gold, red, rust, and a touch of brown
- ¼-yard (actually less) burgundy fabric for inner border
- ¼-yard. (actually less) fabric of your choice for binding, not needed for class
- approx. 1 yard fabric for backing, not needed for class
- -12 5-inch square pieces of foundation paper to make string blocks. Try phone book pages, they are so easy to remove.

Tools:

- -Bonnie K. Hunter Essential Triangle Tool

- -rotary cutter with new blade
- -Rulers: <u>not necessary to own</u>, but bring what you will use to square up the sizes mentioned:
 - -10 ½ inch ruler to square up leaf blocks
 - -2 ½ inch ruler to square up half sq. triangles
 - -4 ½ inch ruler to square up string blocks
 - -5-inch ruler to square up string blocks
 - -6" x 24" ruler for strip cutting
 - -sewing machine, thread, and all related sewing supplies

To Do Before Class:

- 1. Cut out 12 5-inch square foundation papers.
- 2. Organize or cut string strips for 12-5" blocks at ¾" to 2" wide.

Cutting Fabric: always have your ruler line ON the fabric for measurement, and not on the mat.

Depending on how scrappy you would like your table topper, cut each item matching or all the different:

- 1. Cut 2 5" x 5" grey squares
- 2. Cut 2 5" x 5" cream/neutral squares
- 3. From autumn-colored scraps cut $4 1'' \times 8''$ strips for stems.
- 4. Cut $2 2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch grey squares
- 5. Cut 2 2 ½ inch cream/neutral squares
- 6. Cut $4 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " grey rectangles
- 7. Cut 4 2 ½" x 4 ½" cream/neutral rectangles
- 8. Cut 9 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of grey, and 9 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of cream/neutral. One set is for the corner stones.

OR if you want scrappy corner stones:

9. Rather than a 9th strip above of both colors, just cut 8. Then scraps can be used for the corner stones. Cut $8-1\,\%$ " squares in both colors using a variety of fabrics.

In class we will be using 2 1/2" strips to cut half square triangles. In order to have variety, we are not using WOF. Just be sure you have fabrics that you can cut into 2 ½" strips of different lengths from which to cut the half square triangles. We will make 32 HST with grey background and a variety of autumn colors, and 32 HST with cream/neutral and a variety of autumn colors. Call Konnie if you have any questions!
