
## Freestule Churn Dash

2022 December Blocks Pattern

Finished Size: 54" x 68" (without borders)

A Churn Dash Block quilt with a Twist!

The Churn Dash Block quilt is a basic block pattern that has stood the test of time. This popular vintage block is a 9-patch quilt block pattern originating during the mid-1800's. The block's name comes from the pattern's resemblance to the old-fashioned butter churn.



We will be creating a unique quilt utilizing this pattern but with a floral print accent and a white background to give it a unique feel.

Fabric Requirements: 3 ½ yards of white cotton fabric for 180 5" squares

1 package of 10" floral print squares

Supplies: 5" square ruler

White thread

Quilting Needle (only step 4 will require a 90/14 needle)
