July Workshop: Mitered borders and Bindings with a flange

Your borders and binding add the finishing touch to your quilt. To add a little pop to that border and / or binding let's make it special by adding a flange. But why stop there let's do a mitered corner. If you love the way these look on a quilt but you have been afraid to try it then come and have a little fun and see how easy it can be.

You will need 2 projects

- 1. a small project that is ready for the borders and
- 2. one that is ready for the binding

Fabric for Borders and Binding

A contrast / or coordinating fabric for the flange (if you want flange)

You will need to bring

- a good working sewing machine with a ¼ inch pressure foot
- Thread for your projects
- Extra bobbins
- Well-equipped sewing box
- Ruler (at least 6 x 12 but 6 x 24 is best)
- Cutting mat
- Sharp rotary cutter (standard size)
- Pins
- binding clips
- marking pen or chalk that can be seen on your fabric
