New York Beauty – Taught by Kaye Joachim This is a Foundation Paper Pieced Class

Fee: \$45/Student (5 students minimum, 25 spaces available)

Kit Fee: \$10.00 for Foundation Papers & the "A" template payable at time of registration.

A New York Beauty block is a traditional quilting pattern characterized by a series of curved fabric pieces. The design involves four curved fabric pieces (arcs) arranged in a way that forms a unique star-like or fan-like shape.

Supply List:

Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget your foot pedal, sewing machine manual, and cord) plus normal sewing supplies like pins, seam ripper, etc.

Thread

12" or 6" "Add a Quarter" ruler (this is extremely helpful and a real game changer for paper piecing). A 6" x 24" ruler for sizing up your project

A piece of card stock at least 6" (the back of a note pad or a note card or even a greeting card will do) A Rotating mat or a 12" or larger mat is a good idea as you will be doing a lot of cutting and pressing. Rotary Cutter

Best Press

Fabrics: Pick colors that are pleasing to you and coordinate or compliment with each other. OR you can make this totally scrappy. I would suggest at least a 1/2 yard to a yard of each color you chose unless you are going totally scrappy then at least a 5" x WOF of each of your colors. The sky is the limit in color ways.

The Wall Hanging: Approximately 30" x 32"





The Wall Hanging is made up of 4" unfinished squares and 8" unfinished squares. The quilt is all 8" unfinished squares. You can use these squares to make whatever you like, a table runner, bag, quilt, wall hanging, etc. I will give you enough foundation paper pieces to create the wall hanging plus a master copy so you can continue making them at home.
