

Quilt Binding Secrets taught by Anne Johnson

Fees: \$45/student (minimum 5 students, 20 seats available)

Description: During this six-hour class we will cover various methods of quilt finishes and when to use the different techniques. Better mitered corners, facings, incorporating flanged and decorative binding, and machine stitching. The instructor will provide tips and hints on using glue as well as other tools to improve your technique. Students will have time to practice on their own samples.

Supply list

- 4 to 6 sandwiched and pre-quilted placemats (approximately 12" by 18")
- 2.5" Binding for each placemat, basically 2 strips WOF (multiple lengths for each should be widthx2 plus lengthx2 plus 10 inches – we will join strips during class)
- Additional fabric for flange (1.75" by length calculated above)

General sewing supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order with thread to match your pieces
- Erasable marking pen
- Stylus
- Seam ripper
- Small ruler with ¼" markings (I like my 2.5" by 12.5")
- Pokey tool (purple thang) optional
- Scissors and rotary cutter
- Other favorite sewing supplies
