Complete the ENTRY FORM on page 2 of this packet. Complete one ENTRY CHECKLIST and one ENTRY FORM for each item you are submitting. All items on the CHECKLIST should be initialed and the FORM must be completed and signed. Your signature indicates your agreement to the Terms and Conditions.

Take a PHOTO of your quilt. The photo should be a straight-on view of the entire quilt. The quilt does not need to be completed at the time of the photo but should be far enough along that the Quilt Show Committee can recognize what the completed quilt will look like. Photos should be emailed to <u>quilt60@hotmail.com</u> (preferred method), or printed and attached to the Entry. If emailed, include your name and the quilt name as they appear on the Entry form.

_____ Write one CHECK payable to FNQG to cover all your entry fees. Fees are \$10 *per entry* for FNQG members, or \$15 *per entry* for non-members.

In exchange for participation in the 2021 Emerald Coast Quilt Show, I agree to the following:

I agree to loan the entry described on the Quilt Show Entry Form to Flying Needles Quilt Guild (FNQG) for the 2021 Emerald Coast Quilt Show.

I agree to allow FNQG to display my entry at the 2021 Emerald Coast Quilt Show.

I grant FNQG the right to photograph my entry for publicity and/or promotional purposes, which may include print, website, and video.

I can confirm my entry has been completed since February 2018.

I have selected ONE category for each of my submitted quilt(s). While every effort will be made to honor my selected category, I understand the category may be changed at the discretion of the Quilt Show Committee for reasons including, but not limited to combining categories with five or fewer entries.

I understand ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category. There will also be a Best of Show ribbon awarded by the judge, and a Viewers' Choice awarded the last day of the show. Cash prizes will be awarded to Best of Show (\$100) and Viewers' Choice (\$100). No cash prizes will be awarded for category ribbons.

I understand entries considered by the Quilt Show Committee to be offensive may be denied acceptance into the show.

I understand the Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of quilts accepted based on available space.

In the event the Quilt Show is cancelled, I understand my entry fee(s) will be returned to me, and I agree to otherwise hold FNQG, its officers and members harmless for any expenses incurred by me in anticipation of the show.

I agree to hold FNQG, its officers and members harmless for any staining, damage, wear and tear, or theft of my quilt(s) which are in their possession for the 2021 FNQG Quilt Show.

JUDGED CATEGORIES

Select one category which best describes your entry.

- o Large Pieced: an entry which is primarily pieced, with a perimeter equal to or larger than 220"
- o <u>Small Pieced</u>: an entry which is primarily pieced, with a perimeter smaller than 220"
- <u>Appliqué</u>: an entry which is primarily appliqued
- <u>Wool work</u>: an entry (quilt, wall hanging, candle mat, or other item) which is made of at least 40% wool
- o <u>Art</u>: any entry that is considered by the maker to be an art quilt
- <u>Modern</u>: any entry that is considered by the maker a modern quilt, including but not limited to quilts with bold colors, minimalist in design, asymmetrical, improv, or with negative space.
- <u>Hand Quilted:</u> any entry that has been hand quilted, regardless of other machine or hand techniques.
- <u>Hand Work</u>: an entry which contains one or more of the following -- hand piecing, hand appliqué, hand embroidery, hand beading
- Other and Mixed Techniques: any entry that does not fit into the above categories

2021 Emerald Coast Quilt Show - NEXT STEPS

Your quilt show entry is complete and has been submitted, and you have received Confirmation of Acceptance from the Quilt Show Committee. Now what?

Complete the following items in preparation for the quilt drop-off.

- □ First, FINISH YOUR QUILT! Once your entry has been accepted, the Committee is counting on your entry to help put on a wonderful show.
- Add a 4" finished (or larger) HANGING SLEEVE to your quilt(s). Use your favorite method for making a sleeve, or follow the instructions on https://www.quiltweek.com/hanging-sleeve-instructions/.
- Add a QUILT LABEL to the back of your quilt. The label should include, at a minimum, the name of the quilt, the maker's name(s), the quilter's name, and the date the quilt was completed. The quilt name should be the same name appearing on the Entry.
- Cover your QUILT LABEL with a plain piece of fabric using at least two safety pins. This fabric will be removed by the Quilt Show Committee after the judging is complete.
- Place your quilt in a pillowcase or other cloth bag with a label pinned or sewn to the bag (only one quilt per bag). This label should include your name, the quilt name, your address, and your phone number. You can use a purchased pillowcase, or you can make your own pillowcase using your favorite method, or follow the instructions on <u>https://www.joann.com/how-to-make-a-pillowcase-with-cuff/4065882P117.html</u>.
- Quilts must be delivered to the Quilt Show Committee on Tuesday, February 23rd between 9 and 11 a.m. at the Fort Walton Beach Fairgrounds, 1958 Lewis Turner Blvd. Be prepared to tell the Committee who will pick up your quilt at the end of the show (you or your designee). You will receive a Claim Form, which is needed to pick up your quilt at the end of the show.
- Quilts must be picked up at the Fairgrounds at the conclusion of the show (Saturday, February 27 between 5 and 6 pm) by either you or your designee.
