

NEXT STEPS

Your quilt show entry is complete and has been submitted, and you have received Confirmation of Acceptance from the Quilt Show Committee. Now what?

Complete the following items in preparation for the quilt drop-off.

- ☐ First, FINISH YOUR QUILT! Once your entry has been submitted, the Committee is counting on your entry to help put on a wonderful show.
- ☐ Add a 4" finished (or larger) HANGING SLEEVE to your quilt(s). Use your favorite method for making a sleeve, or follow the instructions on <https://www.americanquilter.com/hanging-sleeve-instructions>.
- ☐ Add a QUILT LABEL to the back of your quilt. The label should include, at a minimum, the name of the quilt, the maker's name(s), the quilter's name, and the date the quilt was completed. The quilt name should be the same name appearing on the Entry Form.
- ☐ Cover your QUILT LABEL with a plain piece of fabric using at least two safety pins. This fabric will be removed by the Quilt Show Committee after the judging is complete.
- ☐ Place your quilt in a pillowcase or other cloth bag with a label pinned or sewn to the bag (only one quilt per bag). This label should include your name, the quilt name, your address, and your phone number. You can use a purchased pillowcase, or you can make your own pillowcase using your favorite method, or find a pattern on allpeoplequilt.com/magazines-more/million-pillowcase-challenge/our-top-20-pillowcase-patterns.
- ☐ Quilts must be delivered to the Quilt Show Committee on Tuesday, March 4 between 9 and 11 a.m. to the Rigdon Center, 1958 Lewis Turner Blvd. Be prepared to tell the Committee who will pick up your quilt at the end of the show (you or your designer). You will receive a Claim Form, which is needed to pick up your quilt at the end of the show.
- ☐ Quilts must be picked up at the Rigdon Center at the conclusion of the show (Saturday, March 8 between 5 and 6 pm) by either you or your designee.
