Pam Cortner called the meeting to order at 9:58 am and asked everyone to silence their phones. The prayer and Pledge were led by Linda Weiss.

Membership – Penny Maus: There were 51 members, and 5 guests present.

Newsletter and Minutes: Everyone present received Needle Notes. Inputs for the April Needle Notes are due March 18. Penny Maus moved to approve the February board and general meeting minutes as printed in the newsletter, with Sharon Jacobs seconding. Minutes are approved as written.

Treasurer's Report – Pam Cortner for Anne Johnson The financial report was published in the newsletter. The current bank balance is \$20,631.88.

Friendship blocks should be made in the same color as the strip club. We will collect friendship blocks until they are needed by a member. Penny Maus shared how much she still cherishes the friendship quilt she received 5 years ago when she was going through breast cancer treatment.

Birthdays: March birthdays were recognized. Janet Kinner won the drawing.

Program: This month's program is QUILTO, a quilting version of BINGO. The April program is Quilt Tips. Members are encouraged to share their favorite tips.




