- 1. The meeting was called to order by Pam Cortner at 10:00 a.m.

- 4. Pam asked who did not get the newsletter. Eliza did not. Pam stated that updated contact information needs to be given to Penny.
- 5. A motion was made by Barbi Ouellette and second by Joyce Bean to approve the minutes for the June meeting. The minutes were approved as written.
- 6. Items for the August newsletter are due to Jayne Pendergast by July 16, 2020. Please be sure to send pictures of what you are working on if you did not bring them to the July meeting's show and tell. Sandra is a member of Photoshop and can downsize the photos given to Jayne to make our newsletter more manageable.

- 8. Jo Peppey introduced Sharon Thiel, our guest speaker. She did a trunk show of several of her quilts. They were breathtaking. Sharon was asked what she likes for batting and for threads. Sharon said her favorite batting was Dream Cotton and Dream Request both by Quilter's Dream. She likes Thermore batting for hand stitching. Sharon also likes Mountain Mist and YLI thread for hand quilting.
- 9. Pam asked Kaye for the Nominating Committee update. Kaye said that we still need a secretary and a president for the new board. However, all positions are available. Please see Kaye Joachim, Barbi Ouellette, or Kathy Crews if you are interested in a board position, on or before the August general meeting.
- 10. The updated SOPPs will be in the August newsletter for review. We will vote on the updated SOPPs at the annual meeting in September.
