# Freestyle Churn Dash <br> Lap Quilt 54" x 68" (without borders) 

Blocks are $13.5^{\prime \prime}$ finished.
Fabric and Supplies (yardage based on 42" material):

## Quilt Yardage

$31 / 2$ yards of white cotton fabric for 1805 " squares
1 package of 10 " floral print squares

## Supplies

5" square ruler
White thread
Quilting Needle (only step 4 will require a 90/14 needle)

## General Information

-Please read all instructions carefully before cutting your material and starting the quilt assembly.
-Always use an exact $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
-10 blocks are due in June and 10 blocks are due in November ( 20 blocks total)

## Instructions:

## 1. CUT

From the white fabric, cut:

- (23) $5^{\prime \prime}$ strips across the width of the fabric - Subcut the strips into 5 " squares for a total of 180 using the $5^{\prime \prime}$ square ruler
Cut each of the $10 \prime$ floral squares in half to make (84) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.


## 2. SEW UNIT A

Place the end of a floral rectangle onto a 5 " white square with right sides facing at any angle any angle will do! Stitch pieces together.
*Right sides together


Press the sewn piece over the seam allowance. Turn the piece over ad trim the excess fabric evenly with the 5 " square. Reserve the rest of the floral piece for another unit. You should have plenty left over to do at least one more. Make 4 Unit As per block. A total of 80 are needed for the layout shown.


## 3. SEW UNIT B

Place a floral rectangle over one side of the $5^{\prime \prime}$ white square, with right sides facing, at an angle. Be sure the angle covers the end of the square when it is flipped down and pressed. Sew in place and turn the piece over and trim the excess fabric away evenly with the 5 " square. Press. Again, reserve the rest of the floral piece for another unit. Make 4 Units Bs per block. A total of 80 are needed for the layout shown.


## 4. BLOCK CONSTRUCTION STEPS

*90/14 quilting needle is used for the entirety of Step 4*

## To be completed no later than June

## Block Construction for layout and nesting (the first 10 blocks)

1. Sew a Unit A to either side of the Unit B. Make 2 rows like this.

First and third row seams are ironed to the right for nesting.
2. Sew a Unit B to either side of the white 5 " square. Make 1 row like this. Middle row seams are ironed to the left for nesting.
3. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the block.

Block size: 13.5 finished

## To be completed no later than November

## Block Construction for layout and nesting (the second 10 blocks)

1. Sew a Unit A to either side of Unit B. Make 2 rows like this. First and third row seams are ironed to the left for nesting.
2. Sew a Unit B to either side of the white 5" square. Make 1 row like this. Middle row seams are ironed to the right for nesting.
3. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the block.

Block size: 13.5 finished
Total of 20 blocks.
