#### FNQG General Meeting Minutes 6/10/21

**Pam Cortner** called the meeting to order at 9:59AM and asked everyone to silence their phones. The prayer and pledge were led by **Linda Weiss**.

**Membership- Penny Maus**: 46 members were present, with 1 returning members. The returning member is Joni Haught.

**Newsletter and Minutes**: Everyone present received the June Needle Notes. Inputs for the July Needle Notes are due June 17 to Jayne Pendergast. Penny Maus moved to approve the May board and general meeting minutes as printed in the newsletter, with Keri Kastl seconding. Minutes are approved as written.

**Treasurer's Report- Anne Johnson**: The financial report was published in the newsletter. The current bank balance is \$20,414.69.

An application for the 27<sup>th</sup> Annual Oktoberfest and Arts & Crafts Festival made its way to us. We will return to this application at our July meeting.

**Strip Club- Grace Grimsley:** This month's strips were won by Penny Maus. The July color is florals. Friendship blocks should be made in the same color as the strip club.

**The Bi-laws/SOPP Committee** will have the proposed changes in the August newsletter (30 days prior to being voted on at the September annual meeting).

**Peggy Murrell**- The 3 members of the nominating committee are Pam Cortner, Kaye Joachim, Peggy Murrell. If you are interested in serving on the board, let a member of the nominating committee know. If elected, you'll shadow the position for October, November, and December before beginning in January 2022.

**Kaye Joachim**- Presented information regarding the 2022 Quilt Retreat. The retreat will be held February 25-27, 2022. Linda Weiss, Deborah Moen, and Kaye Joachim checked multiple venues before determining that the retreat will be held at the Hilton Garden Inn. The goal is to have 75 people in attendance per day. There will be no national teacher; classes will be taught by members of the guild. Only 1 vendor will be present at the retreat.

**Community Service- Linda Weiss** would like to thank everyone who has been showing up to workshops, turning things in, and contributing to our community service programs. We will be working on pillowcase kits and layering quilts at the next workshop. Last week, 14 receiving blankets, 5 grab blankets, 4 bibs, and 20 bags were donated to Catholic charities.






