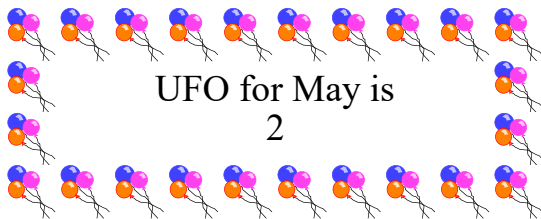


The month of May is the Guild's 30th anniversary! Please see the write-up on the next page.

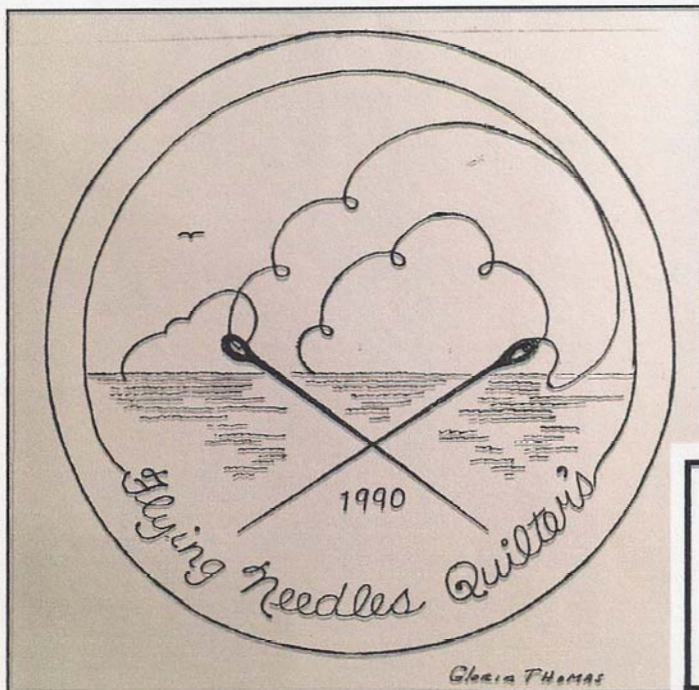

# Happy 30th Anniversary, Flying Needles Quilt Guild!

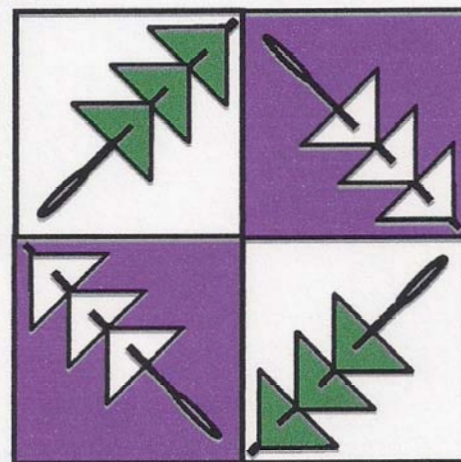
## The History of the Flying Needles Quilt Guild

It all started back in 1989 with a small group of 8 women who shared a passion for making quilts. They would meet regularly in someone's home until many more women wanted to join in on the fun. They made the guild official the next year, complete with a name and a logo, a monthly newsletter, and before long it became a non-profit organization that was involved in giving back to the community. At the present time, we have over 100 members who meet once a month for the general meeting to discuss what is going on, and there is always a great Show 'n' Tell! We also have monthly workshops for lots of projects to include making Christmas stockings and quilts for charities, learning new techniques, and making many Quilts of Valor for deserving military veterans in the local area. The members also combine their talents to work on at least one large Opportunity quilt a year -- many tickets are sold for the chance to win it, and that money is used to help pay for the supplies needed to make the next one. The guild also sponsors a fun quilting retreat every other year, usually in February for a whole weekend of sewing fun. Typically, a nationally known teacher is scheduled to teach a few classes, as well as other local talented people to teach other classes. It is open to the public, and registration is required for this popular event. The guild also sponsors a very popular Quilt Show on opposite years from the retreat, which draws many locals and tourists alike!

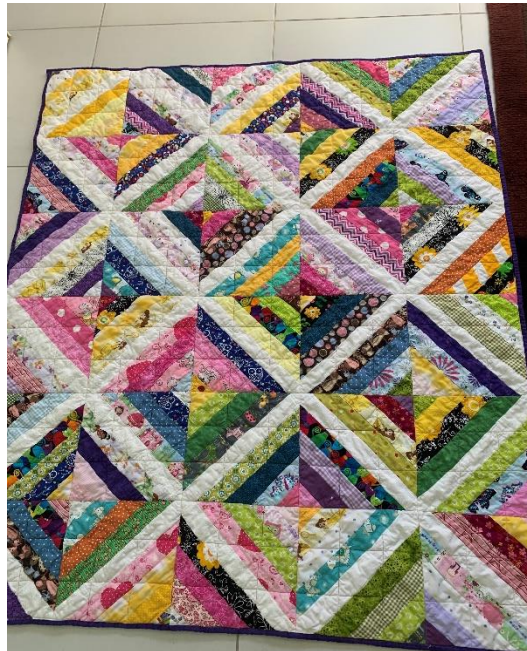

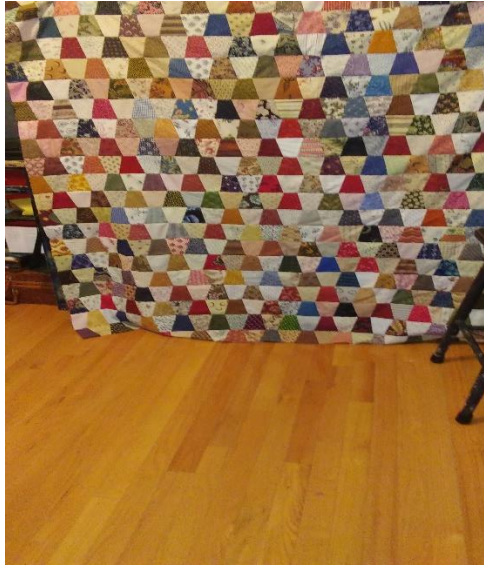
