

THE WORLD OF MEN AND DJINN

Man, (Adam), Mind is the Vice-Regent for the Creator in the physical material world, is "The Crown of Creation". Many have misunderstood the meaning of the word man. Most of us think that the man is synonymous with the male biological form that he uses to manipulate the physical material world. The word man is used to describe the existence of an immaterial non-physical (male/female) being that was created in the likeness and image of its creator. We have come to call this invisible, incomprehensible, unimaginable, indescribable part of the creature, mind. The fact is that within the male body that is made and fashioned from the the Earth's physical matter there exists both Man and Djinn creatures that make up the mind of the human being. Man, and Djinn share a symbiotic relationship in the physical composition of the human brain.

Woman, (Eve), Womb of Mind, made to help man meet his destiny, (And the Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helpmeet for him.") is the "Mother of Civilization". A man goes into a woman and comes out of a woman. A physical female form of woman gives birth to the son of man's physical body. Man and Woman together help to awaken the son of man's mental body. The son of man is able to recognize reality by the amount of truth, introduced via five senses (Touch, Smell, Taste, Sight, and Hearing). The stimulus connects the divine mind to the human brain, allowing his spiritual body to interact through his mental body enabling the physical body relationship with the True Reality of the physical material world and the world of mankind. Woman in the world of mankind is represented as church schools and other social institutions.

Djinn, (Iblis), Essence, controls the subconscious primal "reptilian/serpent," electrical chemical structure (Medulla, Pons, Cerebellum, Midbrain, Globus pallidus, and Olfactory bulbs). responsible for basic survival functions like breathing, heart rate, and basic instincts... MAN means MIND (The meaning of Manu is 'Wise, Attractive, Ruler of the earth, Founder father of human beings. ') Christian Science: the compound idea of infinite Spirit: the spiritual image and likeness of God: the full representation of Mind

Words make Worlds

The meaning of the word

Shit-tan (Satan) The Enemy is not a created being! The Satan is a non-entity. It has no existence of its own. This is a figment that the rational mind (the djinn, mentality) produces in the absence of truth. It functions like a serpent that feeds on lies, illusion, doubts, and confusion.

Human being a creature made from "Humus" the dust of the Earth, (dust and water fashioned into shape) having the spirit of the Creator breathed into His nostrils. The nature of the man is that of water. Man means Mind! The nature of the human being is that of sounding clay. Sounding clay is a type of earth, that when moist with water (morality) can be easily shaped (receive an impression), when set, can be struck (with truth) resonate that which was impressed (the word). The human being has the freedom of choice to obey the word of the Creator or to disobey. The human has the limited free will to choose the direction of growth either from dust to industry or dust to divine.

Djinn is a creature that is now commonly referred to as spirit was created before the creation of man, that ruled a universe that existed before the physical universe. Some of these creatures followed a leader. Lucifer, (iblis) that ranked high among the angels. He and some of his followers who rebelled against the creation of human beings were cast down from the heavens into the dust of the Earth. The nature of the djinn is that of intense fire so hot that it consumes everything and does not give off any smoke. (Electrical chemical reaction.) Djinn only obeys logic and reason. Symbol of Ignorance and Divine Mystery: Besides negative connotations, darkness also serves to represent human ignorance, lack of understanding, and the enigma of divine aspects beyond our grasp. Their face was blackened by their deep thoughts, in the attempt at understanding the unknown.

Asia therefore must signify the inner, the spiritual, in individual consciousness, wherein lay the beginning of man's conscious existence, and wherein lies the dawn, or rise, of the light and wisdom of his new day of spiritual understanding and realization.

Christ: The word Christ (Christo) means in Greek the anointed one, or Hebrew (Messiah) one who is anointed.

Apostle Was an Eyewitness of the Resurrected Christ the anointed one, the son of man born into this world, and live among us must be afflicted and influence by its falsehood and oppression design to crucify his spiritual Christ body (spirt) existence. Being anointed with truth is the physical body (self) to witness the resurrection of the mental body (man).

So one of the men who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord Jesus (PBUH) went in and out among us, beginning from the baptism of John (PBUH) until the day when he was taken up from us—one of these men must become with us a witness to his resurrection. Jesus (Isa) "peace be upon him" God's Holy Prophet did not die on a cross, nor was he ever crucified. In truth it is the body of his teachings. and all of those who believe and follow the corrupted version are the ones who are being crucified!

God: The word God comes from the Gothic translation of the New Testament to represent Greek Theos and Latin Deus. But God, Theos, Deus, Lord, or even Yahweh is not his name.

The word God means that which has power and control over you... The word God is not a name. the proper name of God is Allah!

He has many attributes that he is called upon by his worshipers in whatever language they speak.

The word for God

In Arabic "al-ilāh"

In Hebrew "Elohim"

"Allah" is different to the word "God" in many ways. Bismillah. Asalam mu alaikoom. (with the name Allah, the peace be upon you)

1) Allah means "Al Ilah" Al for "The" Ilah for "God." So Allah means "*The* God" and the Pre-Islamic Arabs who were polytheistic had other "gods" beside Allah but Allah was known as the Immaterial God - they (the pagan Arabs) recognised Allah swt as Al -Khaliq (The creator) but refused him as their "Rabb" (Lord).

So, in reality Allah is the immaterial unseen God.

- 2) Unlike in English the word God can be changed into "gods" "goddesses" "demigods" etc.
- (i) Whereas Allah despite being in a language which like spanish etc. has feminine and masculine (is a gender based language), the word cannot be made into either of these genders and is genderless. Subhanallah!
- (ii) Also the word Allah cannot be made into a plural, and therefore, in the arabic languages there are two words for God: Allah the immaterial God and Ilah "god(s)"

So in reality, when we compare the word "Allah" to "God" we find "Allah" to be more unique and of a befitting nature to Allah itself.

FUN FACT: (for the reasons above - i.e. the uniqueness of "Allah") the bible uses the word "Allah" for God instead of "Ilah" when it is translated in Arabic.

Vice Regent: It means to rule or reign. God has appointed humans as his vice-regents in order to exercise his purposes, plan, and will in all creation. "The Original Man is the Asiatic Black Man, maker, owner, cream of the planet Earth, God of the material world and Vice-Regent in the physical creation."

Humus (Clay)

In classical soil science, humus is the dark organic matter in soil that is formed by the decomposition of plant and animal matter. It is a kind of soil ... the Latin word for Earth. (brown "mortars clay" also known as red clay that when influenced by fire (falsehood) hardens after it being fashioned into shape, but when struck with truth, breaks and crumbles into pieces! The black "potters clay" takes on the shape that it is fashioned then cools in the designed form to be struck with truth resonating the sound of that truth")

The Real World

Worlds are formed by words. The Creator created the universe that we exist, the True Reality with one word "BE" ... and it "is" only by His Will do all things exist. Man is a created being innocent, inquisitive, intuitive, imaginative, with rational mind, limited free will, having the ability of judgment, logic, reason, and abstract thought. The Creator commanded man to name everything in the creation... the mental body of man thereafter would become a mirror of the creation (perceive Truth) allowing the inner world of the mind to interact with the physical material creation. Having this connection, the Creator could then breathe of His Spirit, Will (the breath of life) that would form man's spiritual body and man would become good..., a "Living Soul" (an eternal being).

The world of evil is formed by falsehood. When the true revealed word of the Creator has been concealed or corrupted the Inner world of the mind becomes confused, making it difficult to communicate with the human brain (Mind in Earth) affecting the physical body's emotions and behavior. The more truth the mind receives the more it becomes one with the *Creator...*


The Real Human



Nafs Lawwamah - The Self Accusing Spirit



Nay, I swear by the day of resurrection, I swear by the self accusing spirit!

The object of an oath has already pointed out, is the point to an evidence of what is manifest to establish a truth. It is striking that the resurrection is here spoken of as the evidence of the resurrection. It is really the spiritual resurrection that is evidence of the great resurrection. The clue to this is contained in the verse I swear by

the self accusing spirit, the self accusing spirit (Nafs Lawwamah) is the first stage in man's, spiritual resurrection. It is the stage in which the inner self of man asserts itself when he does evil, the human in man become stronger than the animal in man.

Nafs Ammarah - Self Wont to Command Evil

The righteous never attribute any good to themselves but attribute all good to the great source of goodness, God. Man's self is here called Ammarah, the one wont to control evil. It is in fact, the lowest stage in the spiritual growth of man it is what may be called his animal self. The low desires and animal passions rule the mind of man, and he is capable of doing any evil without feeling any pangs at all. He submits to his carnal desires like the brute. The next stage is called the Lawwamah, which is referred to as the self accusing spirit when the slightest departure from the path of rectitude at once rose the pangs of conscience. The third stage is the stage of perfection. – The Mutma'innah, or the sold at rest when it is in perfect peace, having obtain the goal of perfection those who have attain the goal of perfection are spoken of as those on whom my Lord has mercy.

Form-u-la:

- **Form** Surah, or pattern of design (as in the natural order of things within the divine plan of Allah).
- You Nafs, the characteristics of self (as in the inherent individual make up of the unique details with relation to the being created by Allah).
- La Mustaqiyum, or searcher who has freedom and seeks security (in such case is to give emphasis to the oath, "La-illa ha I'll-Allah" (there is nothing worthy of worship but Allah) "There is no God, but Allah"

Nafs Mutma'innah – Self Contented Soul



The spirit, which is the second stage, although blaming a man for the impurities of life is yet powerless to resist the evil tendencies or to block them out holy and to inform to establish a man upon the principle of virtue with firmness now reaches a stage of development in which its efforts are crown with success. The state of struggle with sinful propensities passes away and entire change, comes over the nature of man and the former habits undergo a complete transformation.




Original Mind

Human Being


Man is created as a single soul male and female

The process of man's creation occurs in three stages. The Creator creates the whole of creation once in a single word (vibration) BE!




Nothing exists, except by the Will of its Creator. The first stage begins as an idea in

The Human Brain



The fall of man


The term "mind of man" generally refers to the totality of mental phenomena, including conscious and unconscious processes, that enable thinking, feeling, perceiving, imagining, remembering, and willing. The mind is not a physical object, but rather a collection of mental functions and processes that are thought to be associated with the <u>brain</u>.



Adam and Eve were warned not to go near the tree of the knowledge of good and evil in the midst of the garden. The roots of this Tree convey Iblis' ancient satanic scheme to prove man unworthy. This tree stands for the descendants of Iblis (Lucifer). They did not live within the garden of Eden. The mist referred to the boundary having a dark and foreboding atmosphere east of Eden. The children of Adam






The man being put into a deep sleep, stands for the time that Adam walked among the djinn inhabitants of the planet. No, the universe was not created from the forces of "light and fire" as commonly understood, but the Big Bang theory describes the universe's origin from an extremely hot and dense state that included immense energy, which was a form of "fire" and generated intense "light". 

The dialogue occurs after God commands all the angels to bow down to Adam, as a sign of respect and recognition of Adam's unique creation and status. Satan, who was among the angels (though from the jinn), refused to obey. Here are the specific verses:


- Surah Al-A'raf (7:12): God asks Satan (lblis) what prevented him from prostrating. Satan replies: "I am better than he; You created me from fire and created him from mud (or clay)".
- The dialogue began with Allah commanding the angels to prostrate to Adam, but Iblis refused. When Allah
 asked Iblis for the reason, he arrogantly stated he was better because he was created from fire, while Adam
 was created from clay. Allah then declared Iblis to be an outcast, and after being granted a respite until the
 Day of Resurrection, Iblis swore to lead mankind astray.

NOTE: These creatures (angels, djinn, etc.,) exist in an infinite creation described as heaven. At the time of this dialogue, there was no physical universe therefore the interval between Iblis and his followers being cast out of the heavens, and the creation of the Earth cannot be determined. The physical universe of time and space is a finite creation that exists within the original creation. NOTE: Before the physical universe, angels and jinn existed in a realm created by God, though their specific domain is debated. Angels were created from light, while jinn were created from smokeless fire. The physical universe was created sometime after these beings, but the exact timeline is unclear.

The Human Nature

The philosophy of human nature explores the fundamental characteristics and dispositions that define humans, including how they think, feel, and act. It's often used to describe the essence of humanity. The concept has been debated for centuries, with differing views on whether humans have a fixed nature or are more malleable

- **Mind vs. body:** Plato emphasized mental and spiritual characteristics, while Aristotle believed the mind and body are inseparable. Some thinkers consider the body part of human nature, while others see it as a container for the human essence.
- Varying perspectives: Philosophers like Confucius and Mencius believed human nature is inherently good, while Xunzi and Hobbes saw it as evil or leading to a "brutish" life. Judeo-Christian-Islamic traditions view human nature as corrupted by sin, but redeemable through God.





The concept of "all things created has its form of worship" refers to the theological idea that everything in the universe, from the smallest atom to the largest galaxy, was created by Allah and therefore exists as a way to glorify and praise Him, essentially acting as a continuous act of worship; this idea is most prominently found in the Bible verse Colossians 1:16, which states "For by Him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities; all things were created through Him and for Him.".

Evolution

Soulful Perspective and Creative Expression: The finite physical material Universe bound by the mathematical laws of time and space was created in the domain of an existing infinite creation by Its creator. The material world is predestined with the order to try the human being from within the inner and outer worlds. Originating from a void that can be referred to as "Aether" the outer world evolved from the vibration of the word, "BE"! Nothing exists, except by the will of Allah (Originator of the heavens and the Earth)!


A field pervading space: In some modern theoretical frameworks, "ether" is used to describe a fundamental field, like the Higgs field, that permeates all of space.

Iblis does not have a fixed physical form on Earth; as a djinn, it can assume various forms, while its original form was described as majestic before its fall. However, in popular tradition and some interpretations, when it is in a human-like shape, it is depicted with specific features such as a menacing grimace, "smoldering embers" for eyes, and seven hairs on its chin.

The Soul's Perspective: The soul man is the original mind, existing in an eternal realm, evolves through the trials, of life and death to decide upon judgment his destiny. They often speak God's truth, which can include denouncing sin, calling people to righteousness, and occasionally foretelling future events. Prophets receive divine revelation through various means such as Angels, dreams, visions, or a "still small voice," and their primary role is to make known God's will and character.

The duty of a warner is to deliver a divine warning, clearly and publicly, about the consequences of disbelief and to call people to repentance and the worship of God. This warning often includes a description of the painful punishment awaiting the unrighteous and the rewards of paradise for believers, serving as a crucial part of their prophetic mission to guide humanity. The prophet is not responsible for compelling belief, but for clearly conveying the message, with the ultimate accountability resting on the individual listener.

The duty of a messenger is to act as an intermediary between a divine being and humanity, delivering messages of divine guidance, warning, and hope. Their roles include calling people to repentance, enforcing divine law, and providing encouragement during difficult times. They serve as messengers for God, delivering scriptures and teachings to guide people toward righteousness and a closer relationship with the divine.

Ending on Earth

Allah allowed the Djinn, (Iblis, and his 300 followers) a time on earth to prove man unworthy to be ruler of the material world. Using lies, deception, and temptation, the djinn mentality in the human brain is able to influence the development of mankind's worlds growth from dust to industry. Genesis

The diinn essence works sub atomically in the physical material world using electrical chemical reaction in certain parts of the human brain. Summary

Definitions:

"Son of Man" has multiple meanings, most commonly referring to a human being or, in a prophetic and theological context, to Jesus and his role as both the suffering human and the divine Messiah who will return to judge. In the Old Testament, it can refer to a human being or a prophet like Daniel.
