

Have you ever thought of commissioning a portrait?

Many of us do not have the opportunity now or perhaps in the foreseeable future to meet up with some of our closest friends and family, and we are looking for other ways to feel connected to them.

I've been very involved in painting commissioned portraits recently and have realised how much these can mean – both to the subject and the person commissioning them.

Over the next few months, I am inviting commissions for a limited number of portraits. These could be of a loved one or a dear friend – as a gift for them or to yourself.

Each portrait will be painted in acrylic on an unframed 16 x 12 inches wooden panel which is ready to be hung and will cost £250 (2020 prices including free P&P and delivery in the UK).

I will set aside time each month for 2 of these commissions, so when I accept a commission, I will be able to tell you when you can expect the work to be completed.

Do contact me sooner, rather than later if you have a special birthday or anniversary date in mind.

Here are some basic terms and conditions.

- I will ask you to provide good quality photographs of the subject and a commission is secured by paying a non-returnable deposit of £50 upon my acceptance of the photographs.
- A completed portrait can be rejected by the person commissioning it at no further cost than the non-returnable deposit.
- I retain copyright of the painting in case I wish to use an image of it for marketing purposes only.
- You may use images of your commissioned painting for personal use but you cannot use it or images of it for commercial purposes.
- If you wish to have a larger portrait painted, for me to provide a frame or if you live outside the UK, then this and the cost must be agreed before work begins.
