Do you know that well [over 20 million adults have earned their diploma through alternative state-testing](#)? Employers, job training programs and colleges acknowledge state earned diplomas through GED and HiSET as evidence of meeting

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the knowledge and competency skills required for a high school diploma. [According to national studies](#), adults without a high school diploma struggle way more than adults with a high school diploma. Adults without a high school diploma tend to maintain income at minimum

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wage. They are also more likely to be unemployed when there is a high unemployment rate, resulting from an unstable economy, high layoffs and a higher demand for employees with an education, at least a high school diploma and competitive skill-sets.

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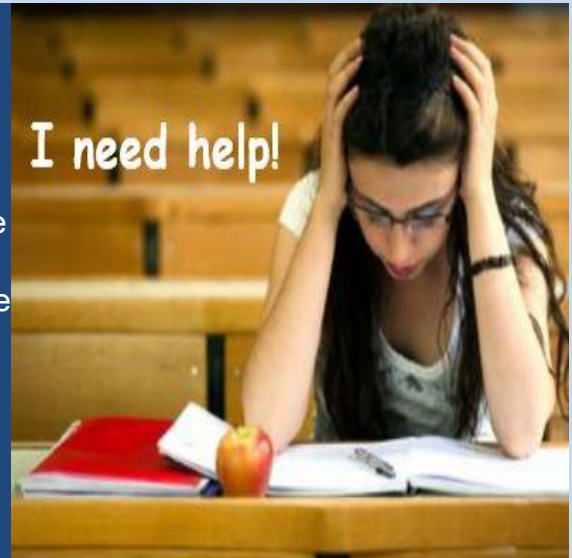


Skills acquired through GED/HiSET Preparation

Adults that complete GED/HiSET courses acquire the knowledge-base and skill-sets of proficiency in mathematics, reading-language arts, science, social studies and writing. In alignment with the common core standards, courses are centered on real-life, so that adults are better equipped for the workforce and college. While some adults may



study for their GED/HiSET independently of instruction, instructional guidance is beneficial to adults because it helps the student to understand information that he/she may not easily grasp. Teachers are also able to present the information in various ways that will help the student to better understand it. They are also able to detect where the gap in knowledge and skills may be present and tailor instruction so that this missing information is acquired. As such, students are more likely to benefit from instructional guidance than not.



The Benefits of Personalized Instruction!

Why personalized instruction? Courses that are personalized are tailored to meet students' individual academic and learning needs. These courses focus on students' areas of strengths and weaknesses and entail lessons that help to improve students' weaknesses at an incremental and steady pace. Students transition into the next lesson or phase of learning once they have successfully learned the previous lesson with at least 80% accuracy. This allows students to learn the prerequisite knowledge and skills needed to understand and grasp the lessons for their next phase of learning on a given topic.
