Alternatives to Achievement: Know Your Options


In 2015, the GED Testing Services made changes to the GED to align it with the Common Core Standards. As a result, there was a significant decline in the number of adults taking the

of state testing. In many states, adults can now earn their H.S. Equivalency Diploma by taking the High School Equivalency Test (HiSET) or the Test for Secondary Completion (TASC). Our program offers students both the GED and HiSET track, but students must reside in a state that offers either one or both of these test options.

- 24/7 access to all coursework.



Meeting Students' Expectation

Last month, our students completed their student satisfaction survey. Out of the eight questions asked by students, students rated us highest in all categories.
