New GED/HiSET Test Fees!

Effective 2019, some states have increased their testing fees for high school equivalency diploma exams. These increases will affect students taking the GED and HiSET exam. So, students who are taking these exams should make sure that they review their state's requirements for testing prior to registering for their official exam.
