### 2020-21 GOALS/OBJECTIVES

YOURpath for Adult Learners' 2020-21 objectives focus on its instructional, attainment, and program goals as outlined below:

#### Instructional:

- ❖ Objective 1: To <u>continue</u> ensuring that every student enrolled in the program has the instructional support needed to advance in their online coursework, moving to the next level of advancement within a three-month span. (This objective is supported by the projected test date tracking log). Goal met.
- Objective 2: Implement a tracking system to effectively monitor students' test-readiness gains (at a minimum of 3 points) on their HiSET practice test and (at a minimum of 5 points) GED practice test and ensure that students are making monthly gains to test within 3-4 months of enrollment (excluding TABE courses). Goal Met.

#### **\*** Attainment:

- Objective 1:To continue ensuring that every student who demonstrates test-readiness is scheduled for his/her official exam within 1 month of testing. Goal Met
- Objective 2: To increase our student high school attainment rate by 15%, to reflect an 80% or above outcome.
  Goal Not Met.

#### Program:

- Objective 1: To increase our student enrollment by 15-20% by the end of 2021, with a focus to increase enrollment among our male gender population. Goal Met, with the exception of increasing male population.
- ❖ Objective 2: To improve our student retention by 15-20% by the end of 2021. Goal Met.












# STUDIENT ENROLLIMIENT BASED ON GENDER

### Per our student enrollment:












### STUDENT EMPLOYMENT STATUS

- 39% (14) of our students are unemployed.







### ENROLLIMIENT RATE

• YOURpath's enrollment rate for 2021 increased by 18%.




**Note:** The enrollment rate was calculated by dividing the current enrollment by the number of students in the previous year enrollment and times by 100 to get the enrollment rate.



### RETENTION RATE

• YOURpath's student retention rate for 2021 is 82%.




**Note:** The Retention rate was calculated by dividing the number of students on the last day of the given period by the number of students on the first day. Then, multiply that number by 100 to convert it to a percentage

Our students are on the following academic tracks:


- 53% (17) of our students are on the HiSET track.

One of our recent graduates was among this population of students.






### ACTIVE STUDENTS TESTING STATUSES

Our students' testing statuses are as follows:


- 6% (2 students) have completed the program during the first half of the year (mid-year).
- 58% (21 students) have tested in 1 or more subject areas.
- 36% (13 students) have not yet tested. The majority of these students are recent enrollees.





### STUDENT HIGH SCHOOL ATTAINMENT RATE


YOURpath's student high school attainment rate for 2021 equaled the end of the year attainment rate in 2020.





### STUDY HOURS FOR YEAR 2021

YOURpath's students' study hours increased from 447.19 as reflected in the last quarter of 2020 to 4116.68 this year of 2021. Students did exceptionally well balancing their coursework load between YOURpath's two platforms, Essential Education and Google Classroom.
