ABOUT OUR 2022 GRADUATES

- **Ms. Jailane** graduated from the program in March of 2022. She passed all of her exams, scoring on the college readiness level in RLA and math. She completed the program in nine months. Ms. Jailane plans to enroll in college to pursue a career in computer science.
- **Ms. Cinthya** graduated in May of 2022. She passed all of her exams, scoring on the college readiness level in writing and math. She completed the program in eleven months. Ms. Cinthya plans to focus on her family before heading to college.
- **Mr. Antone** graduated in December of 2022. He passed all his exams, scoring on the college level in reading and math and scoring 19 out of 20 in science and social studies. He completed the program in ten months. Mr. Antone plans to enroll in college to study business.

2022-23 GOALS/OBJECTIVES

YOURpath for Adult Learners' 2022-23 objectives focus on its instructional, attainment, and program goals as outlined below.

Instructional:

- **Objective 1 & 2:** Ensure that every student enrolled in the program has the instructional support needed to advance in their online coursework. Monitor students' test-readiness gains and ensure that students are making monthly gains to test within 3-4 months of enrollment, if eligible. **Met/Met.**

Attainment:

- **Objective 1 & 2:** Ensure that every student who demonstrates test-readiness schedules their official exam within one month of testing. Increase our student high school attainment rate by 16%. **Met/Exceeded.**

Program:

- **Objective 1 & 2:** Increase our student enrollment by 10-15% by the end of 2022. Improve our student retention by 10-15% by the end of 2022. **Exceeded/Partially Met. Student retention declined in the second half of the year. More resources are needed to improve our retention efforts.**



YOURpath has a total enrollment of 37 students. Our highest population of enrolled students reside in the state of Pennsylvania.









- 38% (14) of our students are unemployed.













Our students' testing statuses this year 2022 are as follows:


- 8% (3 students) completed the program in 2022.
- 68% (25 students) have tested in 1 or more subject areas.
- 24% (9 students) have not yet tested. The majority of these students are recent enrollees.



STUDENT HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY (HSE) ATTAINMENT RATE

YOURpath's student high school attainment rate increased by 20% in 2022 from 2021.

We exceeded our attainment goal this year.



HSE LITERACY GAINS

YOURpath's average gains for our GED/HiSET program were as follows:

- **HiSET Track:**

- **Reading:** Students made a 7-point gain, from 6.0 to 13.0, near the college readiness level of 15.0.
- **Essay Writing:** Students made a 2.5-point gain, from 1.0. to 3.5, a proficient skill level.
- **Math:** Students made a 10-point gain, from 4.0 to 14.0, near the college readiness level of 15.0.
- **Science:** Students made a 5-point gain from 8.0 to 13.0, near the college readiness level of 15.0.
- **Social Studies:** Students made a 6-point gain from 8.0 to 14, near the college readiness level of 15.0.

- **GED Track:**

- **RLA:** Students made a 50-point gain, from 116.0 to 160.0, near the college readiness level, 165.0.
- **Math:** Students made a 47-point gain from 112.0 to 159.0.
- **Science:** Students made a 49-point gain from 113.0 to 162.0, near the college readiness level of 165.0.
- **Social Studies:** Students made a 40-point gain from 114.0 to 154.0.

ABE/ESL LITERACY GAINS

YOURpath's average gains for our ABE/ESL students were as follows:

- **HiSET Track:**

- **Reading:** Students made a 7-point gain, from 6.0 to 13.0, near the college readiness level of 15.0.
- **Essay Writing:** Students made a 2.0-point gain, from 1.0. to 3.0, a proficient skill level.
- **Math:** Students made a 10-point gain, from 3.0 to 13.0, near the college readiness level of 15.0.
- **Science:** Students made a 6-point gain from 6.0 to 12.0.
- **Social Studies:** Students made a 7-point gain from 5.0 to 12.0.

- **GED Track:**

- **RLA:** Students made a 50-point gain, from 116.0 to 160.0, near the college readiness level, 165.0.
- **Math:** Students made a 47-point gain from 112.0 to 159.0.
- **Science:** Students made a 49-point gain from 113.0 to 162.0, near the college readiness level of 165.0.
- **Social Studies:** Students made a 40-point gain from 114.0 to 154.0.

SUMMARY OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Since YOURpath's inception, we have witnessed remarkable results:
- We **graduated eight students** from our program. Three students graduated from our program in 2022, increasing our H.S. equivalency diploma attainment by 20% from 2021. They all graduated at/near the college readiness level in reading and mathematics. One out of the three scored at the college readiness level, scoring 19 out of 20 in both social studies and science.
- On average, our students increase their literacy skills and attain their diploma within six to twelve months after being out of school for decades.
- Eighty-six percent (86%) of our Graduates have scored on the College Readiness Level.
- Sixty-eight percent (68%) of our students have officially tested.
- One hundred percent (100%) of our Graduates have enrolled in higher learning or acquired employment at the high school requirement level.
- We have maintained a retention rate of seventy-nine percent (79%); and a ninety-five percent (95%) student satisfaction rate.
