However, this statement needs to be clearly stated by restating your thesis statement (e.g. your position statement and three main ideas) and summarizing your main points. You also need to transition into this statement better. For example, you can say, "In summary,.... or To sum it up...

Lastly, you want to make sure that you leave a lasting thought with your audience about your position on the topic.
