A Deeper Dive into Essay Writing:

Writing is a skill that can be fun, if we embrace it.
However, it takes a lot of work to brainstorm ideas and then organize those ideas so that you construct a well-written, organized and cohesive essay. In our 2019 Online

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GED/HISET Cohort, we have been putting in the work to get our students ready for the essay writing portion of their LA Writing exam. By breaking down the components of an essay: Introduction, Body and Conclusion and diving deep into each section, our students

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are developing the necessary skills to demonstrate a level of proficiency on their official essay writing exam. Students are developing the skills to read two passages and take a position on a given topic based on what they have read. They are learning how to present their position through a

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clearly stated thesis, strengthen by each main idea that they intend to discuss in the body of their essay. Students are being made aware of the importance of transitions as they work on ensuring that they present a logical, cohesive essay. While students may have initially been concerned about writing on unfamiliar topics, they continue to demonstrate progress as they show improvement in identifying and citing supportive textual evidence (T.E.) and giving a reasonable explanation of the T.E. based on their own understanding. Students apply extensive feedback (as seen above in red) to improve their drafts in order to submit their final essay draft online as part of their personalized writing coursework. Our intensive essay writing has proven to be successful in terms of students' developing the skills that they need in order to demonstrate proficiency on their official exam.
