Identify ways in which we could broaden our students' experiences online by offering them online courses through our google classrooms. Today, our students are able to complete their reinforcement work through google classrooms. Here, students are able to upload their assignments and get instructional feedback. Students can apply their feedback to make the necessary corrections so that they are able to resubmit their assignments for further instructional feedback and/or a satisfactory grade (80% or better). These courses enable students to gain a stronger subject/content knowledge base as they prepare for official testing in a given subject area. The uniqueness that YOURpath for Adult Learners has discovered about google classroom is that instructors are able to create text-sets per each subject area that allow students to delve deeper into each lesson in order to gain a better understanding of the concepts that are being taught. So, while our old world has been shaken by an unwelcome intruder, our new norm has permitted us to once again explore beyond our self-imposed limitations and restricted realities.
