Outcome Measures: Where are we to-date?

YOURpath has had the pleasure of experiencing remarkable results in student achievements since our inception in 2018. We have also been fortunate to witness outstanding results during the first of the year 2022. To view our **mid-year outcome measures report**, <u>click here</u>.

- 19% of our students have graduated from the program, consisting of seven students with three students pending completion.
- 68% of our students have officially tested in more than one subject area, with 03% earning a
 perfect test score of the college readiness level.
- 86% of our Graduates have scored on the <u>College Readiness Level</u> in at least two subject areas, primarily reading, language arts, and mathematics.

- 100% of our Graduates have enrolled in higher learning (i.e., vocational training or college) or acquired employment at the high school requirement level.
- We have maintained a retention rate of 82%; and a 95% student satisfaction rate among our students.

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
