seminar cover topics such as number senses and operation, algebra, geometry, data analysis and probability with a focus on word problems. The materials in our the Writing Seminar focus on applying the various components of an essay to include the essay's introduction (i.e. background and thesis), body (i.e. main ideas, supportive statements, and counterargument/rebuttal) and conclusion (i.e. restatement of the position statement (thesis) and summary of main points). We use this opportunity to familiarize students with the official GED/HiSET rubric so that they have an understanding of how their essay will be evaluated for scoring. We have been fortunate to witness enormous success from our essay writing/coaching as students' essays have improved from a rubric score of 0 to 3 and 4 levels of proficiency. Both, our Math and Writing Seminars are an excellent way for our adult students to receive reinforcement in these subject areas and feel comfortable with asking questions and getting an on the spot response to help bridge their gap in knowledge.
