Snow Valley Racing Association Athlete Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to all athletes registered and participating in any Snow Valley Racing Association sanctioned event. (e.g., training sessions, training camps, or races).

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to promote a positive and safe environment by making athletes aware of Snow Valley Racing Association's expectations of appropriate behaviours. Snow Valley Racing Association will not tolerate conduct that brings discredit to competitive skiing, or to the Snow Valley Racing Association and/or its members and athletes.

- 1. All athletes are expected to be aware of, and adhere to, the expectations described in the Alberta Alpine Ski Association Code of Conduct.
- 2. All athletes will train and compete with an open and positive attitude toward attaining their goals.
- 3. Every athlete is required to demonstrate a good attitude toward fair play in sports.
- 4. All athletes shall respect and obey the rules and instructions as outlined by the coaches and/or chaperones.
- 5. Every athlete shall, always, observe the accepted safety rules, referred to as the Alpine Responsibility Code.
- 6. No athlete shall use or posses' drugs that are prohibited, controlled, or restricted.
- 7. No athlete shall commit an indictable offense under applicable federal, provincial law.
- 8. No athlete shall cheat, lie, or use foul and offensive language or participate in any prank or cause nuisance which would discredit the sport of competitive ski racing, the persons involved or Snow Valley Racing.
- 9. No athlete shall be rude or impolite or exhibit other inappropriate behavior.
- 10. No athlete shall consume alcohol, cannabis or use tobacco while participating in any Snow Valley Racing sanctioned activities.
- 11. No athlete shall enter a hotel room not registered to Snow Valley Racing without the permission of the coaches or chaperones.
- 12. No athlete shall invite a person not directly associated with Snow Valley Racing into a hotel room registered to Snow Valley Racing without the permission of the coaches or chaperones.
- 13. All athletes shall respect all private and public property and shall not deliberately cause willful damage.
- 14. All athletes shall respect the property of other teammates.
- 15. No athlete shall use training video for any purpose other than specifically outlined by the Snow Valley Racing Association coaching staff, including perceivably rude or otherwise inappropriate behaviour.

Possible Penalties for Breaching the Snow Valley Racing Association Athlete Code of Conduct

Any athlete found in breach of the Snow Valley Racing Association Athlete Code of Conduct will be subject to any or all the sanctions outlined in Snow Valley Racing Association Discipline Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- 1. Immediate suspension from training or racing.
- 2. Parents contacted, and arrangements made to send the athlete home.
- 3. Future suspensions from any or all Snow Valley Racing Association activities and events.
- 4. Other action that maybe deemed appropriate or necessary (i.e., apologies, assignments, public service) by the program director, coaches, and/or the Snow Valley Racing Association Discipline Panel.
