RAMP Registration Guide

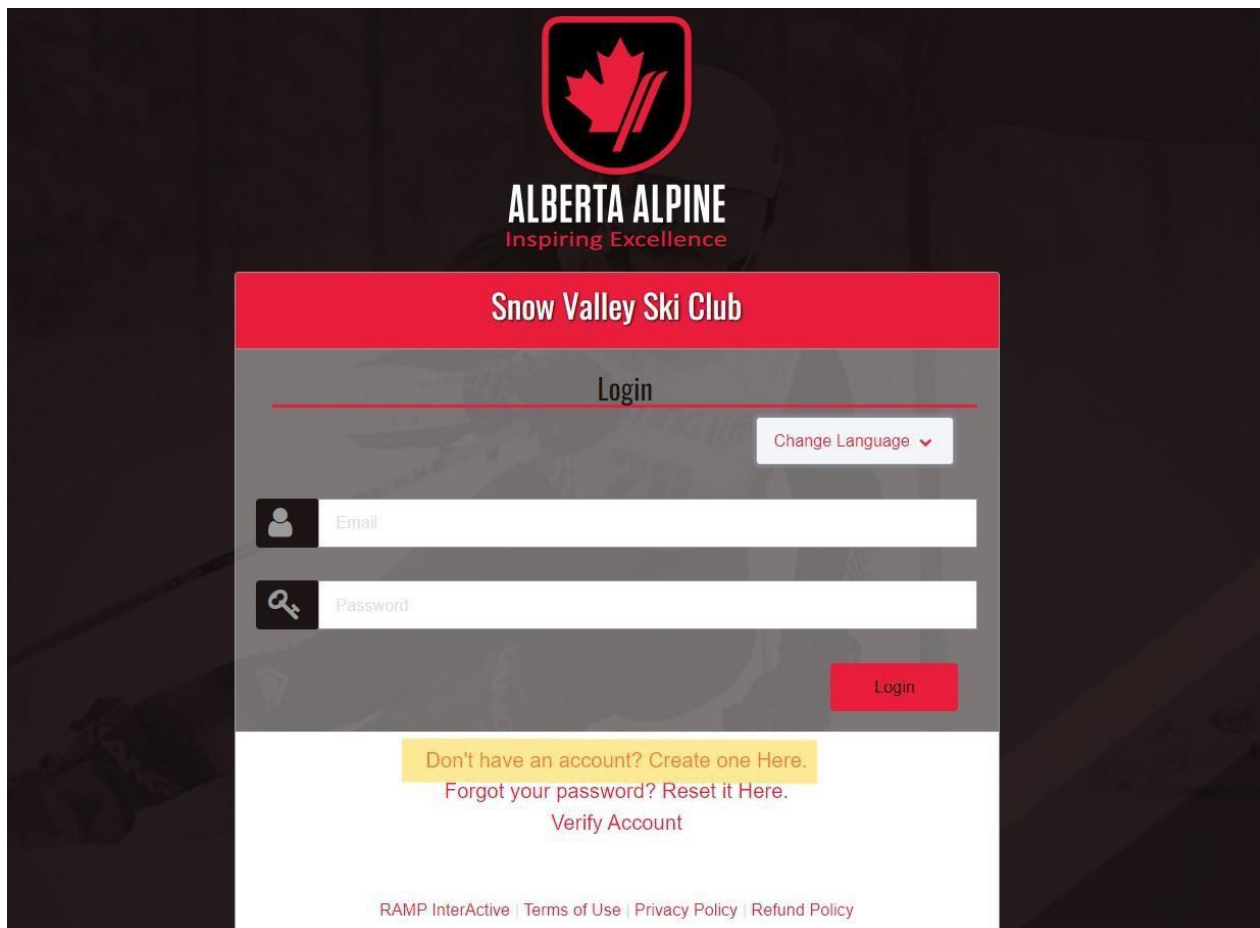
- It is **mandatory** for all clubs (parents and athletes) in the province to use the platform RAMP for 2026/2027 AASA season fees.
- RAMP registration must be completed before registering with Snow Valley Racing on Zone4.
- You will receive a confirmation email from RAMP per individual registration. The SVR Zone4 registration link will be emailed after you complete athlete registration. Please make sure that all athletes in your family are registered on RAMP before registering them on Zone4.
- Note, parents must register first as General Members before RAMP will allow you to register athletes.

1. Create a RAMP account.

Note: If you already have a RAMP account, go to 'My Account Members' and make sure that both parents and your athlete have a profile, and that **all information is accurate and up to date**. Then skip to Step 3 (on page 6)

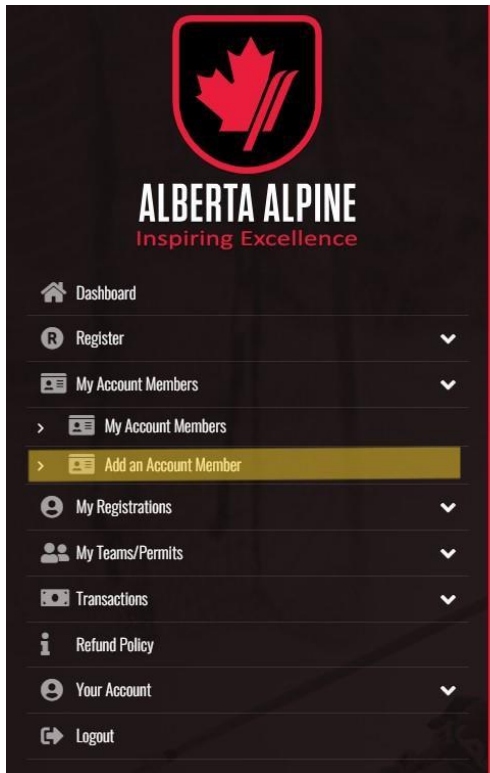

2. Create a profile for each family member.

- a. “Add an Account Member” and create an individual profile for each family member (each parent/guardian and each athlete(s) must have their own profile). (image 2.1)

Note: You do not need to create a profile for siblings or family members who do not ski race.

- b. **Provide the following information:** name, birthdate, gender, address, cell phone, and email.

Note: Please use the cell phone and email address for the primary parent on athlete profiles.

- c. **You do not need to provide the following information:** respect in sport certificate, NCCP, photo, birth certificate, government issued id, vss file, crc file, proof of residency, or treaty/status/Metis card. (image 2.2)

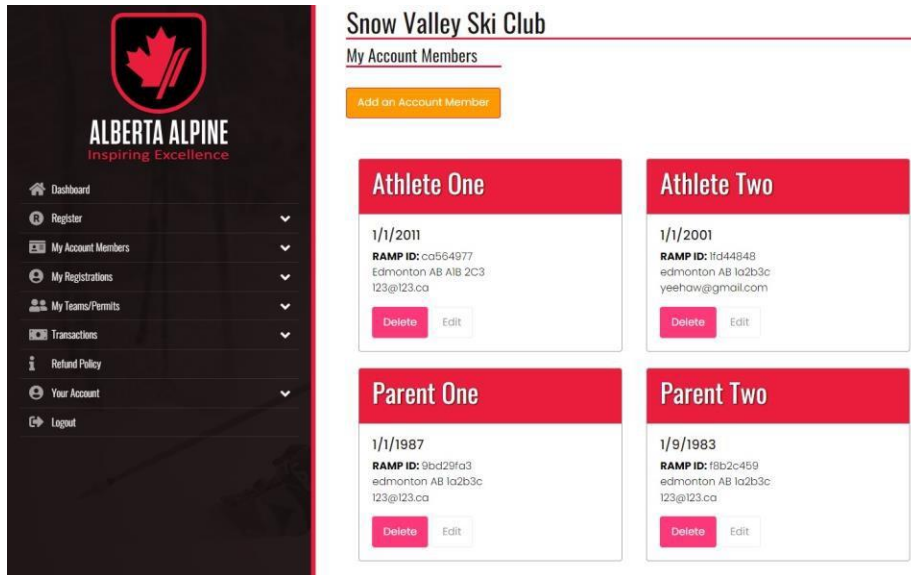

- d. Once you have registered all your family members, your account should look like image 2.3 below!

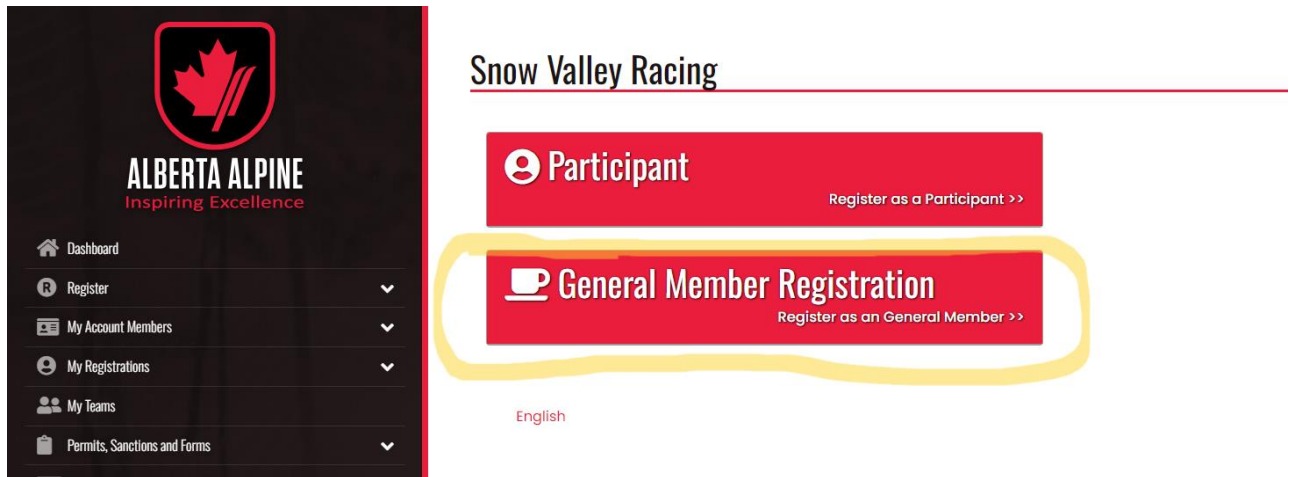
PLEASE double check that every family member's personal information (name, DOB, gender, etc.) is inputted correctly.

Now you are ready to register with Alberta Alpine! See step 3.

3. Registration Process: PARENTS (or guardians)

- a. All parents/guardians will register as General Members (image 2.4)

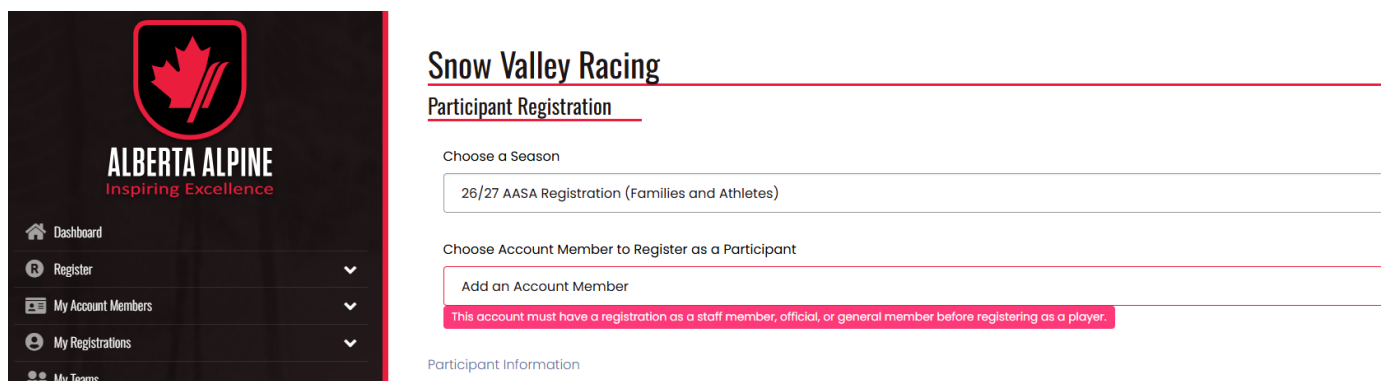
You must do this first before the system will allow you to register your athletes.

Both parents/guardians of the athlete must be registered with Alberta Alpine for the season. Parents only need to pay the membership fee (\$105) one time when they are registering with the first parent. The second parent also needs to be registered but will not have a fee to be paid.

Note: If you try to register your athletes/participants before registering parents as a general member, the following error will come up (image 2.5)

- b. Click General Member Registration (image 2.6)

Choose your season, account member, and division.

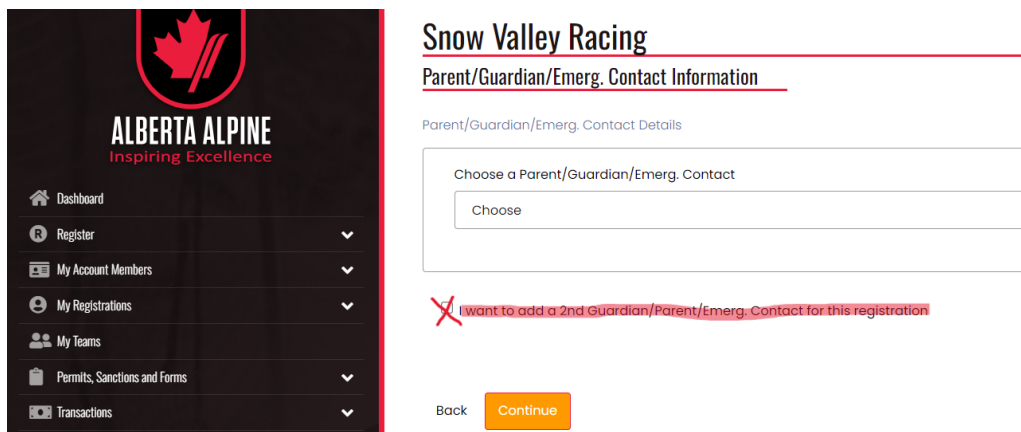
Season: "2026-2027 AASA Registration"

Position: "STEP ONE: Parent/Guardian ONE (Family Membership)"

Account Member: Choose a parent/guardian to register. Both parents/guardians must register with Alberta Alpine for the season.

Press the 'continue' button at the bottom of the page to sign waivers/consent/acknowledgments

- c. RAMP will request an emergency contact for each parent being registered (image 2.7). Choose the alternate parent as an emergency contact for the parent you are registering for (ie. parent two will be parent one's emergency contact, and vice versa). You do NOT need to provide two emergency contacts.

- d. Check-out and pay for parent/guardian Alberta Alpine season registration.

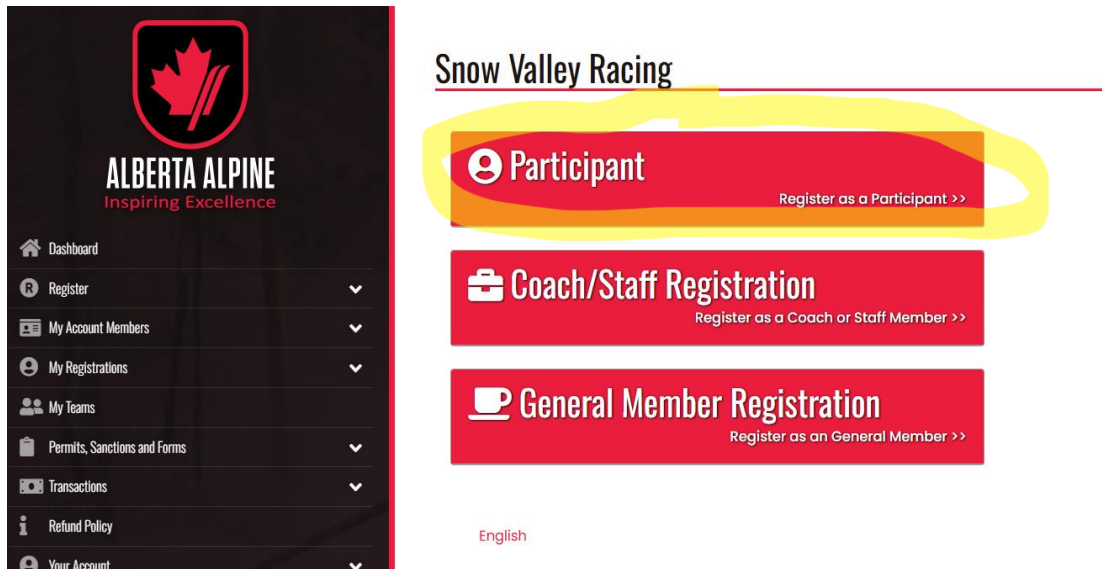
Register the next parent/guardian. You will not be asked to pay a fee again.

Once both parents/guardians have registered, move onto step 4 to register athletes.

4. Registration Process: ATHLETES

Note: PLEASE double check that your athlete's data has been entered correctly. **Mistakes** could prevent your athlete from being able to register and participate in a race.

- a. Each athlete must be registered as a "participant". (image 4.1)

- b. Choose your season, account member, and division. (image 4.2)

Season: “2026-2027 AASA Registration”

Account Member: Choose the athlete you wish to register.

Division: Your athlete’s division is based on their birth year. Please make sure your athlete’s division is correct. They can only participate at races in the division they are registered for.

Division Options are:

- i. U8- Entry Level: Ages 4, 5, 6, 7 as of December 31st, 2026

Note: “U8 – Entry Level” encompasses both Dream Team/U6.

- ii. U10 – Entry Level: Ages 8, 9 as of December 31st, 2026
- iii. U12 – Recreational: Ages 10, 11 as of December 31st, 2026
- iv. U14 – National Card: Ages 12, 13 as of December 31st, 2026
- v. U16 – National Card: Ages 14, 15 as of December 31st, 2026
- vi. 16-21 – National Card: Ages 16-19 as of December 31st, 2026

Note: Because this registration is with AASA, it does not matter if the athlete is in regional or provincial or flex or full time or Entry level or National Card. It only matters what age division (i.e. U8 or U14) they are in.

The fees you pay to Alberta Alpine are dependent on your athlete's age division (plus RAMP and administration fees).

- U6 / U8 pay \$188/per athlete
- U10 pay \$230/per athlete
- U12 pay \$239/per athlete
- U14 pay \$369/per athlete
- U16 pay \$369/per athlete
- U19 pay \$369/per athlete

- c. Complete the required Alberta Alpine Waivers, Consents, and Acknowledgements and then continue to the next page. (image 4.5)

Concussion Policy for Consent

Any Alberta Alpine Ski Association (AASA) athlete under the age of 18 years suspected of having sustained a concussion/traumatic brain injury must be removed immediately from participation in AASA sporting event (e.g. sanctioned training, practice, camps, competitions or tryouts), by the Technical Delegate or AASA member coach overseeing such sporting event. The minor athlete will be prohibited from further participation until evaluated and cleared in writing to resume participation in AASA sporting events by a qualified health care provider trained in the evaluation and management of concussive head injuries. The health care professional must certify to AASA in the clearance letter that he/she has successfully completed a continuing education course in the evaluation and management of concussive head injuries within three years of the day on which the written statement is made.

Upon removal of a minor athlete from participation for a suspected concussion/traumatic brain injury, the AASA TD or member coach making the removal must inform AASA Member Services. Athletes who have subsequently been medically cleared to resume participation must provide such medical clearance (as described above) to AASA Member Services in order to be permitted to participate in AASA sporting events.

About Concussion

A concussion is a type of traumatic brain injury (TBI) caused by a bump, blow, or jolt to the head. Concussions can also occur from a fall or a blow to the body that causes the head and brain to move quickly back and forth. Doctors may describe a concussion as a "mild" brain injury because concussions are usually not life-threatening. Even so, their effects

- e. To finish the registration, you will be required to complete a few more questions (relatively basic information such as gender preference and athlete primary contact information)

Congrats! Your athlete is now registered with Alberta Alpine. Repeat the process (including payment of Alberta Alpine fees) for each additional athlete you need to register.

Once you complete registration, you will receive multiple confirmation emails from RAMP (one for each parent/general member, and one for each athlete/participant).

The athlete/participant confirmation email will include the link to Zone4 for Snow Valley Racing registration. **Only one Zone4 registration needs to be completed per family.**
