Maybe it was a stranger, Bedecked in necklaces and rings? That piqued your interest , in Masonic things.


Whatever it was, I ask, you to remember it well. For as long as you breathe, that's a story you should tell.

Do you remember the excitement, as you tread upon the lodge floor, words being spoken, and knocks, getting louder, than the ones given before?


> Do you remember the pride, by which your fear was smothered? When the master took your hand, and first called you brother?

But time wears on, rendering boulders to grains of sand. It drains the energy, of even the strongest man.


Zeal and fervency, and an undeniable sense of pride, give way to lethargy, defeat, feelings of despair begin to rise.

over that glorious Holy Book.


Remember!
