Test/Trial Hours

Trial Hours: 7:30 AM until complete - **Day of Trial Entries close 7:45 am**

Trial Roll Call: 8:00 AM - ALL Hounds, early Roll for Field Committee, followed by draw.

JC/QC tests will be run first thing after Roll Call. If a hound passes the required QC Test and the owner/handler wishes to enter the subsequent trial, the AKC Coursing Director has granted this club permission to accept trial entries following the test. Entries in this case will be accepted for a period of 15 minutes immediately following the announced finish of the QC Test.

Eligible Breeds and Registry

Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjjs, Borzois, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis and Whippets (Sat and Sun only) that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with The American Kennel Club, or part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the United States of America and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry, or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Qualified Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser. Those sighthounds enrolled in AKC's FSS (Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portugese Podengos (Medino and Grande) Thai Ridgebacks) which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class are eligible to compete in lure coursing tests and trials and will be awarded the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Qualified Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser only.

Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration or ILP pending". Breed disqualifications apply.

Portugese Podengos Pequenos and FSS breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

Conditions of Entry

- * Hounds must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- * Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period.
- * Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused (with entry refunded).
- * All hounds will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.
- * Spayed or neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered.

First time open entries using ASFA or CKC Field Champion Waiver must Submit a Copy of the Championship Certificate with Entry.

Stakes Offered

AKC JC and QC TESTS – offered both days

The **JUNIOR COURSER TEST** is open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 1 year of age. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed at least a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

The **QUALIFIED COURSER TEST** is open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 1 year of age. A hound (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.

The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. Upon successful completion of the Qualified Courser test, the judge completes a certificate and awards it to the handler.

This certificate must be submitted to the host club with the hound's first entry in an Open Stake. The certificate must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC.

AKC REGULAR STAKES:

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Qualified Courser Title, CKC Field Champion Title, ASFA FCh Title. Championship points may be awarded from this stake. Whippets who have earned an AKC Field Championship are not eligible to enter Open.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all hounds, which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SINGLES STAKE:

Singles: Will be offered. Open to all hounds. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter.

Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

Best in Field (BIF) will be offered both days

Ribbons and Prizes

First - Blue, Second - Red, Third - Yellow, Fourth - White, Fifth - Pink

Best of Breed - Purple and Gold

Best in Field - Red, White and Blue

Junior Courser/Qualifying Courser – Green

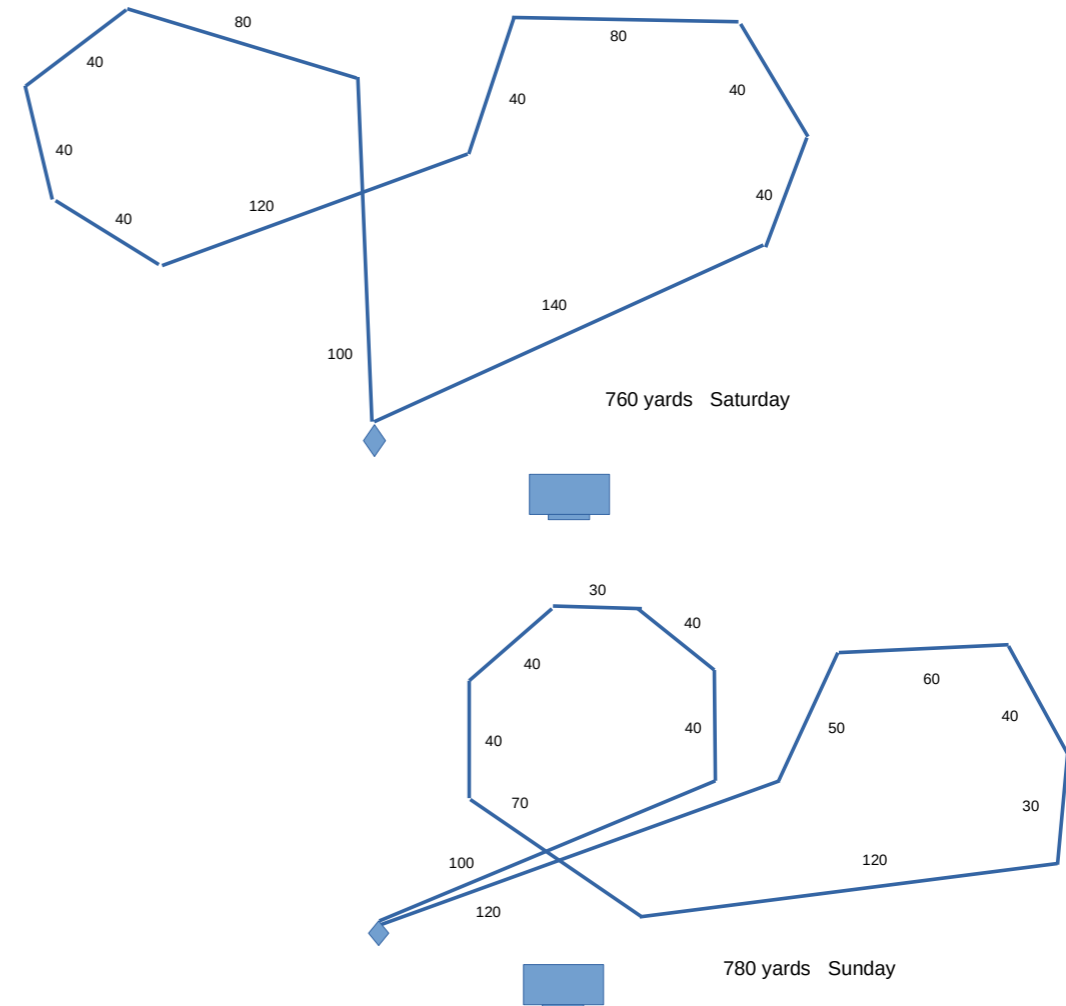

Field

The field has little shade and has natural and fence boundaries.

Please bring your own shade and water.

Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips. The members of the AWC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial. The field will be reversed for the finals, runoffs, Best of Breed, Best In Field.



Neither CLCS, nor its members will be responsible for any accidents at this trial.

How to enter your dog and earn AKC Titles

- * **FIRST** - you want to start with practicing your dog to make sure they will follow the lure and then move to practicing with other dogs (this is to make sure they are not interfering either aggressively OR playfully) - Practice is offered on Saturday after the trial is finished. Times may vary.
- * **NEXT** - if your dog has practiced successfully with other dogs (not interfering either aggressively OR playfully), you should enter him in the QC TEST. Your dog must first earn a **Qualifying Courser (QC)** certification before they can compete with other hounds.
- * To Enter the QC TEST sure to CHECK OFF "QC" ON THE ENTRY FORM and bring a filled copy of the "**Qualified Courser Certificate**" at the end of this Premium list. The Judge must sign this form and a copy of this certificate is required for their first time entry in the open stake.
- * **NEXT-** if your dog has earned a QC TITLE and you feel like they have practiced enough with other dogs, you can enter them in **Open Stake** and work towards the Senior Courser (SC) title. If your dog also wins a placement he will earn points towards his Field Championship title. (See Rule book for point schedule.)
- * To enter in the Open Stake: CHECK "OPEN" ON THE ENTRY FORM, **BRING A COPY OF THE QC CERTIFICATE** AND PAY THE ENTRY FEE FOR OPEN. There is no additional fee for the SC leg. To earn the SC title, the hound must run with at least one other hound, and must receive qualifying scores at FOUR (4) AKC trials under two different judges or judging panels.
- * When your dog has earned the SC title, he most likely will still be competing for Field Championship points. If he receives qualifying scores in 25 trials, he will earn the Master Courser (MC) title.
- * The title of **Field Champion (FC)** is a prefix to a hound's name. It is earned by obtaining 15 points from the Open or Veteran stakes. Dog must win 2 first placements worth 3 or more points under two different judges or judging panels (majors).
- * **FINALLY!** If your dog who has earned his Field Championship title must be entered in the **Special Stake**. **They are no longer eligible to enter the open stake. However they can continue on to work towards an LCX title!**

Practice

Will be held Saturday, after the trial, if weather, equipment and daylight permit. Practice is \$3 per dog/run. Priority will be given to sighthound breeds. All dogs are welcome!

Practice will NOT be offered on Sunday.

From the North: Follow 97/521/601 into Camden. Where it becomes Broad St. - after you pass the railroad track, run Right onto Polo Ln. Follow Polo Ln to the field. Polo Lane is very narrow street (about 1 car width). Watch for signs.

From the South: On I-20 in SC take Exit 92 onto US-601 North Truck/Springdale Dr. (first traffic light past Wal-Mart). On 601 North Truck, Travel past Springdale racecourse to Hwy 97. Turn right onto Hwy 97. Hwy 97 blends into Broad St. On Broad St. after you pass the railroad tracks, turn Right onto Polo Ln. Follow Polo Ln to the field. Polo Lane is very narrow street (about 1 car width). Watch for signs.
