CHECKLIST FOR ARCHITECTURAL / LANDSCAPE MODIFICATION

Prior to initiating a "project" on the exterior of your home or property, we ask that you consider whether the work you have planned will constitute that you complete an Architectural & Landscape Application. Please use the following checklist to determine if you need to submit this document in its entirety to the board for changes/modification that you anticipate making.

Projects that do NOT require an application	Projects that DO require an application
Replacing or repainting your siding, trim or shutters a similar color to the current color scheme	Replacing or repainting siding, trim or shutters to a be an entirely different color(s)
Replacing windows or doors with a similar style/color	Adding windows or doors to existing structure where not already present
Reroofing with a similar dimensional shingle as the one you currently have	Reroofing with an <i>alternate</i> building material, other than dimensional shingles, or adding solar panels
Repairing or using a sealant on your existing concrete driveway to refresh, no color change	Adding a parking pad/additional concrete spot to your driveway
Refreshing decking or repainting existing spindles on railing a similar color	Adding to garage or adding (onto) a patio/deck
Adding landscape block, brick, pavers or concrete trim around planting beds	Building up with landscape material to create fence or barrier / wall
Adding an additional tree, bushes or flowers to your landscape (Note: Hot tubs are permitted but lap pools are not)	Installing bushes/shrubs or trees that will significantly change your landscape and/or reside near a property line
Repainting lamppost or mailbox (See <i>Reference Links</i> at deerpathhoa.com for approved colors)	Replacing lamppost or mailbox (See <i>Reference Links</i> at deerpathhoa.com for approved styles and colors and if within guidelines then no application is necessary)

Additionally, with or without approval from the Board/Architectural Control Committee (ACC), you must check city ordinances and codes, as well as obtain necessary permits with the city for projects that warrant such action. We urge all homeowners to abide by all laws and regulations that might affect the project (completion) in any way.

Homeowner/tenant will assume all responsibility for any costs and liabilities for personal injury or property damage, regardless of the time of occurrence, which arises out of the project. It is implied that the homeowner/tenant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Deer Path Homeowners' Association, Inc., its officers and directors, its management, and all other owners from any costs or liabilities which might arise.

It is suggested that homeowner/tenant obtain a certificate of insurance from any contractors (if any) hired to perform the proposed construction. All contractors should have public liability coverage, with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence, to protect homeowners and Deer Path Homeowner's Association, Inc., its officers, and directors, as well as the ACC, from any personal injury or property damage resulting from the
