Medium concentration in color, with shades of violet. Aromas of black fruit such as blueberry and blackberry. An appealing wine, with elegance and some complexity, freshness and good acidity to it. Smooth tannins, showing some structure in the finish. Pairs with grilled meat, mushroom risotto and soft cheeses.

Yellow, citric color, with peach and passionfruit notes and hints of tangerine. On the palate it shows youth, with vibrant acidity and a mineral fresh finish.

Light straw color, fine and persistent bubble. In the mouth it has a beautiful acidity, balanced with a dry and crunchy finish. Goes well with all kinds of salads, white meat, sushi and grilled fish



Crystal color, notes of white fruit and wet stone, clearly showing the profile of two years old lees, a vegetable and austere on the nose. In the mouth it has a lot of structure and an impressive volume in the mouth, in which the wood toast combines perfectly with the buttery on the palate.

Medium concentrated ruby color. Notes of red fruits and a certain mineral profile that gives it freshness. Consistent wine, with regular quality, which presents the character of the region. Lightly structured, with soft tannins and a vibrant fruit that invites you to sip another glass

Cristal and bright color, with hints of tropical fruit and citrus. On the palate it shows youth and freshness, with a vibrant acidity and an engaging mouthfeel.

The barrel aging allowed this wine to stand out from all its most mineral characteristics. Floral in aroma, but in harmony with the barrel. Very complete, with a remarkable volume and structure, since the first tasting. The citrus notes and the minerality give freshness to the wine, keeping the aftertaste vibrant and long.





Deep ruby color. Very dense but at the same time balanced. Notes of figs, black husks and some spices. Very elegant and fresh in the mouth. The balance between fruit and tannins is perfect. Excellent volume in the mouth, complex and with a long and intense finish. Port with an excellent aging potential.

VINHO Grandes Escolhas: 17.5/20 Pts



The 2020 Branco Reserva Especial Herédias (Terroir d'Origem) is a blend of 40% Viosinho, 40% Rabigato and 20% Gouveio, sourced from centenarian vines and aged for just one month in new French oak. It comes in at 13.7% alcohol. A little flinty, but reasonably concentrated and energetic, this has freshness to go with the seemingly unctuous texture that simply coats the palate. This serious and tightly

wound white should age well, probably better than

indicated.

Lilás by Carlos Lucas

Intense ruby color denoting youth. Aromas of plum and red fruits, with soft and silky tannins. This wine shows the simplicity of the Douro region, with freshness and good acidity combined with red fruit and floral touches.

Wine Enthusiast: 92 Pts (2017 Vintage): This is a finely structured, dense blend of Touriga Nacional and Touriga Franca. Dense black fruits with smokiness as well as spice from wood aging are still developing, leaving tannins to soften over the next few months. Drink from 2022.

Lilás by Carlos Lucas

Clear and transparent color, noting the freshness immediately. With citrus aromas and a mineral touch, this wine presents the elegance and youthfulness of Douro wines. End of mouth with citrus notes, vibrant acidity and well-marked freshness.
