On January 1st, 2023 ended and 2024 began. We hope to make 2024 a great year for the Exchange Club, and giving back to our community.



2/11 - COMMONWEALTH NURSING HOME




On Sunday, February 11th, we donated the flowers created for the Family Sweetheart Ball to Gloucester House Commonwealth Nursing Home.




2/23 - 3/3 - HUMANE SOCIETY DONATION


