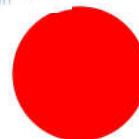

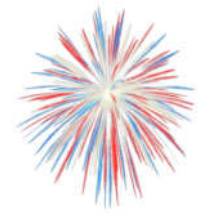
BOYS & GIRLS CLUB/MATHEWS YMCA FLAG GARDEN

PATRIOTS GRILL FLAG GARDEN

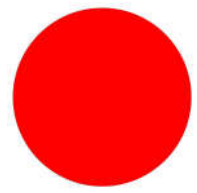


In celebration of the 4th of July, we went out to Patriots Grill and planted an American flag garden.

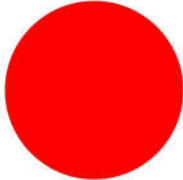

On August 3rd , we donated 17 school kits to Botetourt Elementary School, which will be distributed to school children in need.



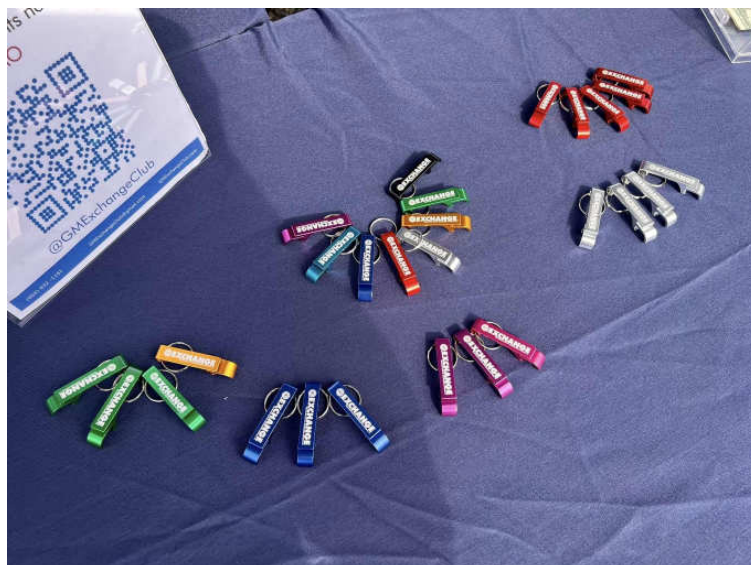

FIRST MEMBER YARD SALE

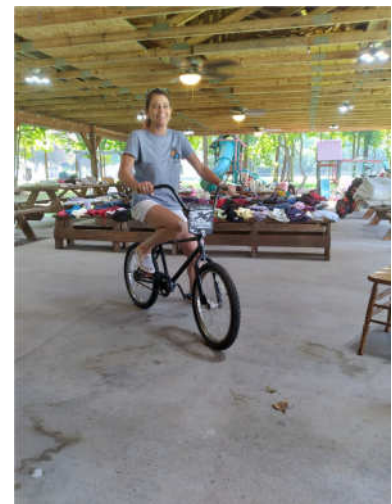


On August 12th, we had our Community Yard Sale event. A portion of the proceeds will go to Village Dog Resource, a local animal rescue group.
