OPERATION CHRISTMAS SHOEBOX – 10/6

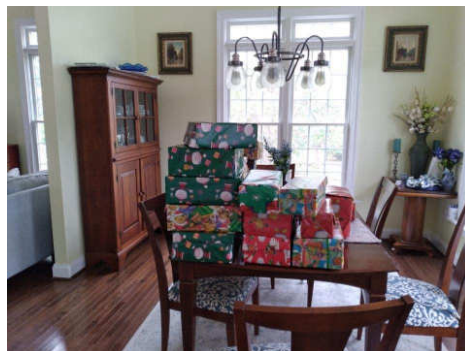

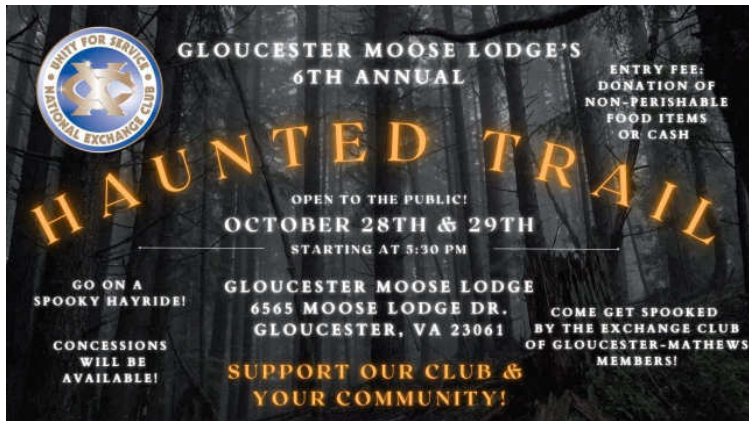

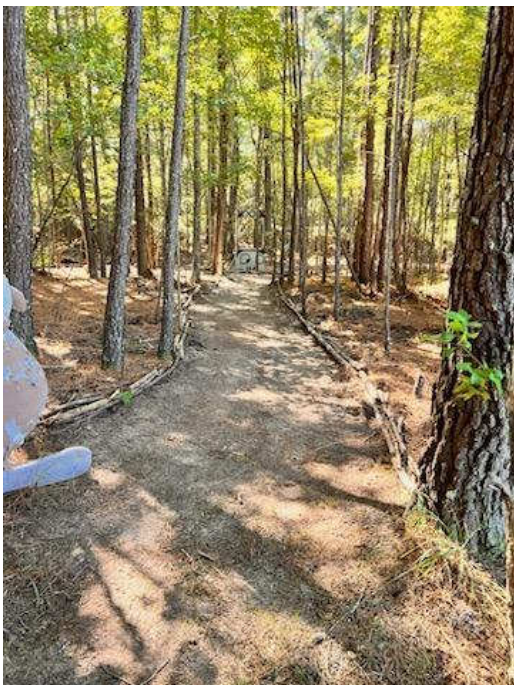
HAUNTED TRAIL CLEANUP – 10/9

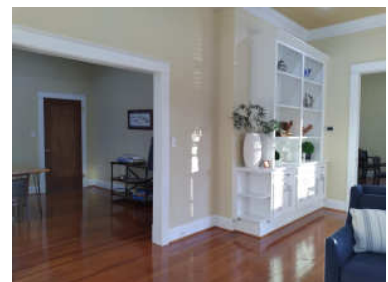
