 Due to the pandemic all of our scheduled dates are subject to change. We will always be mindful of our dancers and their families while planning activities.



ACCOUNTS

Each family has already been issued a credit for paid recital fees, recital keepsakes, recital flowers, sweethearts dance tuition, recital teddy bears, summer camps or workshops.

This credit will automatically apply to your tuition for the current season or will be available to use for one full year towards tuition, registration fees, camps or workshops.

TUITION (JULY ONLY)

- Due to to our shortened season only one monthly payment is due
- July tuition payment & auto draft will be due on July 6th
- Accounts must be paid in FULL to receive recital tickets.

Recital fee will be added back to accounts for students participating in the recital.

Social Distancing Policy for Dancers & Parents

Please review our new protocal and help us keep everyone safe.



Drop off / Pick Up

• Dancers will enter and exit through the glass storefront side. (wait in your car until someone waves you in)

Other Precautions

- Dancers will be asked to use hand sanitizer before entering and when leaving
- Marks will be placed on the floor to help with social distancing
- Please bring a disposable water bottle from home (our water cooler will not be available)
- Dancers please use the restroom at home before coming to class
- We will also be taking extra measures to clean and sanatize before and after every class

Lobby

- Our Lobby will be closed as a waiting area, please stay in your car during class times
- Only one parent or guardian will be allowed into the lobby at a time through the back door to make payments or ask questions

Masks

- All instructors will be wearing masks
- Parents and dancers who enter our building are encouraged to wear a mask however it is not mandatory while dancing
- · Our plan is to minimize the intensity of the classes so dancers can remain comfortable
- We will continue to follow the CDC guidelines and make changes to this policy when we feel safe doing so

What if my dancer isn't ready?

• If for any reason you are not comfortable or confident in these safety measures, please keep your child home and take classes via ZOOM. The option to take any class on Zoom is available.



- Anyone uncomfortable with sending their child to the studio for any reason at this time
- Anyone with a dancer or family member that feels ill or has a fever
- Anyone living with an immunocompromised family member
- Anyone living or interacting with elderly people on a regular basis
- Anyone that has been exposed to someone that has tested positive from COVID-19
