

## Communication

## Class Policy

- Classes are limited to 5 dancers. Wait list will be available for closed classes
- Classes may be cancelled or changed at anytime
- Dancers who arrive more than 10 minutes late will not be allowed to take class
- Only water is allowed in the studios, No food, drinks, or gum is allowed in class

## Absenteeism

- NO refunds for missed classes or for dropping a class mid-season.
- Make-up classes may be available, but are NOT guaranteed.
- Please inform us if you will be missing or dropping a class.

## Drop Off—Pick Up

- Park by the glass storefront doors facing Hwy 14
- Dancers, wait in your car until a teacher waves you inside (dancers will not be allowed to sit outside or in the dance room to wait)
- Parents of dancers ages 3-5 are asked to stay in their cars nearby the first few weeks to aid with social distancing if needed
- After class dancers will be dismissed through the glass doors one at a time

## Lobby

- Our Lobby will be closed as a waiting area, please stay in your car during class times
- Only one parent or guardian will be allowed into the lobby at a time through the back door to make payments or ask questions

## Snow Days / In-climate Weather

- We follow the Nixa School District ([if they are closed so are we](#))
- Each class is allowed one snow day per season without a scheduled make-up.
- If a class misses more than one day due to inclement weather, a scheduled makeup or replacement class will be offered.

## Other Precautions

- Dancers will be asked to use hand sanitizer before entering and when leaving
- Marks will be placed on the floor to help with social distancing
- Young dancers props will be assigned for the year and cleaned regularly
- Bring a disposable water bottle from home (our water cooler will no longer be available)
- Dancers please use the restroom at home before coming to class. Help us STOP the potty train.
- We will also be taking extra measures to clean and sanitize before and after every class
- Classes will dismiss 1 -3 minutes early to aid with cleaning

## Mask Policy

- All instructors will be wearing masks
- Parents and dancers who enter our building are encouraged to wear a mask
- Our plan is to minimize the intensity of the classes so dancers can remain comfortable
- We will continue to follow the CDC guidelines and make changes to this policy when we feel safe doing so

## Temporary Closure due to a Pandemic or Other

- If the studio were to be temporarily closed your account will be frozen.
- Any tuition, costume fees, recital fees, workshop or camp fees will remain as a credit on your account.
- This credit can be used up to one year after we re-open.
- No refunds for prepaid tuition, costume fees, recital fees, workshop or camp fees
- If costumes have been ordered and there is a shut down you will receive your costume (no credit will be allowed)

- Hair pulled away from face in ponytail, braid or bun

### Tap

- Solid color tank or leotard with dance shorts, tights or leggings
- Capezio Fluid Tap Shoes
- Hair in a bun or french braid

### Boys Ballet, Tap & Jazz

- Black shorts or dance pants, solid color shirt with a dance belt or compression shorts

# Tuition & Fees

## Yearly Registration Fee

**1 Dancer \$40 2 Dancers \$60 3 Dancers \$80**

- Registration Fee is non-refundable
- Dancers must live at the same address

## Tuition

- Tuition is divided into 9 equal payments & due on the 1st of every month. (Sept-May)
- Tuition includes all holiday breaks and one snow day
- All payments received by a credit card will be charged a 4% convenience fee
- Payments made with a check or cash will not be charged a convenience fee
- Every family must have a credit card on file.
- If accounts are not current by the 10th of the month, a \$10 late fee will be applied and your credit card will be charged with a 4% convenience fee.
- Class sizes are limited to 5 dancers. Due to these restrictions we will no longer be able to offer sibling discounts on classes.
- Students who are more than one month behind on tuition payments, will not be allowed to return to class until account is up-to-date, including late fees.
- \$25 Bounced Check fee. After two bounced checks accounts must be paid in cash or with credit card.
- A student that drops out in the middle of a pay period, that pay period is still owed. No refunds for that pay period are eligible.
- Classes may be cancelled or changed at anytime.
- There are no refunds. (in the event of a studio closing you will be given a studio credit for any pre-paid classes, camps, workshops, costume, registration and recital fees.)

## Costume Fee due November 1, 2020

### Young Dance Program

**\$65 Discover Dance**

**\$80 Creative Combo (2 in one costume)**

### Core Dance Program

**\$80 Per Costume**

- Costume fee includes all accessories (hats, gloves, tights, hair pieces etc.) and simple alterations.
- Dancers need their class required shoes for the performance.
- Costume Fees are non-refundable.
- Costume fees paid after November 1, 2020 will have a \$10 late fee added

## Recital Fee due on March 1st, 2021

**\$100 Per family (add \$15 for each additional dancer)**

- The recital fee covers the costs for our professional recital.
- Includes one recital shirt, 2 complimentary tickets to the recital, and a digital download of the recital performance.

## 6 Week Workshop & Camp Policy
