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WISCONSIN RIGHT TO LIFE ENDORSES NIC CRAVILLION

Leading pro-life organization latest in growing support for campaign

NEW FRANKEN, WI — Nic Cravillion, candidate for the Wisconsin First Senate District, announced today that his campaign has been endorsed by Wisconsin Right to Life, a leading statewide advocacy organization dedicated to protecting the rights of preborn children and other vulnerable populations in the state.
