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CRAVILLION WINS GOP PRIMARY

Cravillion advances to November after decisive Republican primary victory

NEW FRANKEN, WI — Nic Cravillion declared victory Tuesday night in the Republican primary for Wisconsin's First Senate District, earning more than 9,000 votes and over 40 percent of the vote according to unofficial results, and thanking voters across Northeast Wisconsin for placing their trust in a local farm kid, Army combat veteran, small business owner, husband, and father to be their voice in Madison.
