CRAVILLION SIGNS NO TAX INCREASE PLEDGE

New Franken candidate for Senate leads the way in taking on reckless spending in Madison

(NEW FRANKEN) ...Nic Cravillion, candidate for the Wisconsin First Senate District, signed the Taxpayer Protection Pledge today, committing to oppose any effort to raise taxes on Wisconsin citizens and to vote against any net tax increase if elected to the State Senate.
