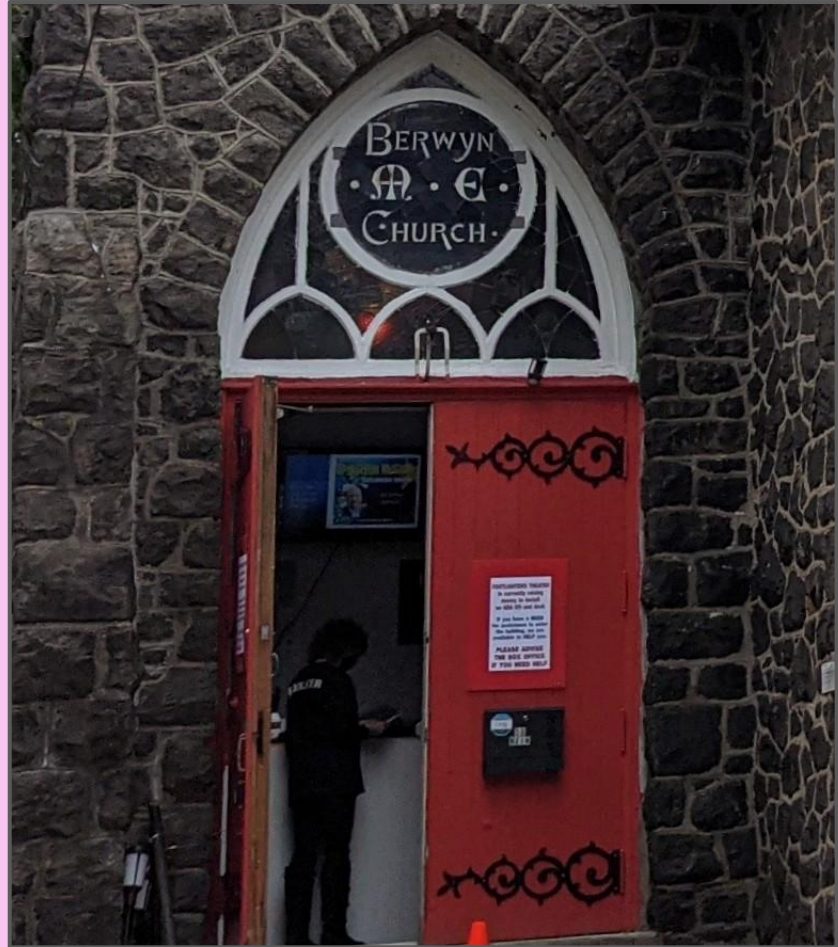
What to expect at Footlighters Theater

an aisle or front row seat if I do
not want actors interacting with
me.

The show will begin at 2:00.

If I need to take a quiet break during the show, I can go outside and sit on a bench or at the picnic table. I can also go downstairs and sit on a couch or chair.

The show will last about 2 hours including a 15 minute intermission. During that time I can use one of the two bathrooms or buy a drink or snack. I may need to wait in line for my turn. The bathroom and snack bar are both downstairs. The bathrooms are available to use throughout the performance.
