The theater will be open at 1:30. There is open seating, I can choose my seat, I will not sit on an aisle or front row seat if I do not want actors interacting with me. The show will begin at 2:00.

This show is a musical with a live band on stage, frequent singing, and dancing.





If I need to take a quiet break during the show, I can go outside and sit on a bench or at the picnic table. I can also go downstairs and sit on a couch or chair.

The show will last 2 hours including a 15 minute intermission. During that time I can use one of the two bathrooms or buy a drink or snack. I may need to wait in line for my turn. The bathroom and snack bar are both downstairs. The bathrooms are available to use throughout the performance.




About this Performance

The story is funny, at times absurd, and touchingly honest,






Throughout the performance you can expect
