- 2. Payment in full via invoice sent to the responsible party after registration form is submitted.

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS

This show is being held concurrently with the FCHC APHA/PtHA/All Breed Show. Entries for the Western Dressage Show will be taken online only and all fees must be paid in advance. Cancellations made before the closing date will be refunded less the office fee. No refunds will be issued for cancellations made after the closing date. In case of hazardous weather, Acts of God, or accidents, FCHC reserves the right to cancel classes. Entries may be transferred or refunded at FCHC's discretion on a case-by-case basis.

ATTIRE

USEF rules and guidelines will be used for attire and equipment. For more information, please visit www.usef.org.

REQUIRED ATTIRE

- **OPTIONAL ATTIRE**
- 1. Suitable western hat. (Protective headgear may be worn without penalty (See GR801) and is STRONGLY recommended.)
- 2. Long-sleeved shirt with any type of collar. (Short sleeves may be worn at the judge's discretion.)
- 3. Trousers, pants, or a one-piece long sleeved equitation suit provided it includes a collar.
- 4. Boots with distinguishable heel.

- 1. Necktie, kerchief, bolo tie or pin.
- 2. A vest, jacket, coat and/or sweater.
- 3. Spurs. (Western style, with or without blunt tines, English dressage style, roller ball, and blunt bumper spurs are permitted. Rowels must be vertical. Spurs with sharp tines are not permitted.)
- 4. Chaps, shotgun chaps, chinks, armitas, or split riding skirt.
- 5. Protective headgear is acceptable; not required to be of Western style.

SHOW PROCEDURES

Limitations: A horse may be ridden up to a MAXIMUM 4 times per day per show, regardless of the number of riders

Class Setup & Rules: . INTRO, BASIC, LEVEL 1 AND ABOVE will use WDAA tests, which are available at www.westerndressageassociation.org/wdaa-tests. Exhibitors may review the WDAA rules at www.westerndressageassociation.org/western-dressage-rules-guidelines.

Show Arena: INTRO and BASIC classes will be held in a small (40m x 20m) arena. All other classes will be held in a large (60m x 20m) arena.

Warm-Up Arenas Warm-up arenas are located outside the two main arenas. Warming up is not permitted inside the show arena on Saturday or Sunday. A separate longeing area is available; longeing is not allowed in the warm-up areas.

SCHEDULING & REQUESTS

Ride Times: Will be posted at www.showfchc.com and emailed to exhibitors no later than the Wednesday before the start of the show.

Special Scheduling Requests: Riders may have special scheduling needs due to trailering arrangements, trainers who are both riding and coaching, or riders managing multiple horses. While these requests are not guaranteed, every effort will be made to accommodate them.

- If the requested class time is available, it will be scheduled accordingly.
- If it is not possible to schedule the class at the requested time, efforts will be made to schedule special request rides before the rest of the class to minimize delays for other participants.

Please note that requests involving a variety of tests can be challenging to fulfill, but we will do our best to accommodate them. Additionally, scheduling takes place after the closing date. Therefore, if a ride is scratched because a special request cannot be honored, it will still be considered a scratched ride, and the ride fee will remain due.
