 Community Update — 1845 (6:45 p.m. EDT) — Wednesday, July 15, 2026

👍 The Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) has confirmed that THU057 (0.2 ha) is out. That fire is fully wrapped up.

🔥 At this time, THU051 (15 ha) remains the only fire in our immediate area still listed as Not Under Control, but crews are making strong progress. MNR crews have been carrying out an aggressive attack on this fire today. That means they're hitting the fire hard and seeing results.

Residents can expect continued activity from MNR as they work this fire, and Nolalu Emergency Services Team (NEST) will keep sharing updates as new information comes in.

☁️ Cloudy, cooler conditions in the forecast — along with the potential for rain this week — will help support ongoing firefighting efforts.

🚒 Two NEST crews (6 volunteers) are on the ground between Kivela Road West and Palisades Road in the Municipality of Neebing assisting crews with wildfire THU058 (6 ha).
