1. Purpose of This Policy

This Privacy Policy outlines how Cargo Metals (a trading name of Integrax Global Partners Corp.) collects, processes, stores, and protects personal and corporate data in the course of its trading operations and website activities. Cargo Metals is committed to handling all data responsibly, transparently, and in accordance with applicable data protection laws and regulations in the Republic of Panama.

2. Legal & Regulatory Framework

This policy is aligned with the data protection and privacy laws, regulations, and supervisory requirements applicable to Cargo Metals in the Republic of Panama, including the rules applicable to its business activities, ownership structure, and data handling obligations.

Specific legal and regulatory references are included for context and are intended to reflect the requirements applicable to Cargo Metals' activities in Panama. The Company undertakes to maintain this policy in line with the requirements actually applicable to it, and to update it as those requirements evolve.

3. Scope of Application

This policy applies to:

- Clients and suppliers engaged in trade transactions
- Agents, brokers, and logistics partners
- Visitors to the Company's website or digital platforms
- Any individual or entity submitting data to the Company

4. Types of Data Collected

The Company may collect the following categories of data:

- Contact details — name, email address, telephone number
- Company registration and ownership information
- Trade documentation — invoices, contracts, shipping and inspection records
- Financial identifiers — bank account details and payment references
- Website usage data — IP address, browser type, and cookies
- Identity documents of directors and ultimate beneficial owners, collected for KYC/AML compliance purposes

5. Legal Basis for Processing

Cargo Metals processes personal and corporate data under the following legal bases:

- Performance of a contract — where processing is necessary to execute or manage a trade transaction or business relationship
- Compliance with legal obligations — where processing is required by applicable AML/CFT, tax, or regulatory law
- Legitimate business interests — where processing supports the Company's commercial operations and does not override the rights of data subjects
- Consent — where the data subject has provided express consent and where no other legal basis applies

6. Use of Personal and Corporate Data

Data collected by the Company may be used for the following purposes:

- Facilitating and managing trade transactions
- Conducting customer and counterparty due diligence (KYC/AML procedures)
- Communicating with clients, suppliers, and counterparties
- Complying with regulatory, tax, and reporting obligations
- Improving operational efficiency and service delivery
- Detecting, investigating, and preventing fraud, financial crime, or policy violations

7. Data Sharing & Disclosure

Data may be shared with the following categories of recipients:

- Banks and trade finance institutions — for payment processing and financing purposes
- Logistics, freight, and inspection partners — for the execution of trade transactions
- Regulatory and law enforcement authorities — upon receipt of a lawful request
- The Company's Resident Agent in Panama — for compliance with Law 52 of 2016 and applicable AML/CFT obligations
- Internal departments — for operational and compliance purposes

Cargo Metals does not sell, lease, or otherwise transfer personal data to third parties for commercial purposes.

8. Data Retention

All personal and corporate data shall be retained for a minimum of **seven (7) years** from the date of the relevant transaction or the closure of the business relationship, unless a longer retention period is required by applicable law. Data that is no longer required for its original purpose and is not subject to a legal retention obligation will be securely deleted or anonymised.

9. Data Security Measures

Cargo Metals implements appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal and corporate data against unauthorised access, loss, alteration, or disclosure, including:

- Secure servers and encrypted communications channels
- Access controls, authentication protocols, and audit trails
- Staff training on data handling, confidentiality, and information security
- Regular review of security measures in line with evolving risks and technology

10. Rights of Data Subjects

Individuals whose personal data is processed by the Company may have the following rights, subject to applicable law:

- Right of access — to obtain confirmation of whether their data is being processed and to receive a copy of that data
- Right to rectification — to request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data
- Right to erasure — to request deletion of data, subject to applicable legal retention requirements
- Right to restriction — to request that processing be limited in certain circumstances
- Right to object — to object to processing based on legitimate interests

Requests should be submitted in writing to: compliance@cargometals.com. The Company will respond within a reasonable timeframe and in accordance with applicable legal requirements.

11. Cross-Border Data Transfers

Cargo Metals operates across multiple jurisdictions and may transfer personal or corporate data to countries outside the Republic of Panama for the purposes of trade execution, compliance, and operational support.

Where such transfers occur, the Company shall ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place, including contractual protections or regulatory approvals, and that the receiving jurisdiction offers an adequate level of data protection consistent with the standards applied in Panama.

Cargo Metals endeavours to comply with applicable data protection requirements in the jurisdictions in which it operates, including those of its trading counterparties and financial partners. 12. Website Cookies & Tracking

The Company's website may use cookies and similar tracking technologies to enhance user experience, measure website performance, and collect analytics. Cookies that are not strictly necessary for the operation of the website will only be placed with the user's prior consent.

Users may manage or withdraw their cookie preferences at any time via their browser settings. Disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality of the website.

13. Policy Governance & Review

This policy is reviewed at least annually by the Legal & Compliance Department and updated as required by changes in law, technology, or business operations. Material amendments are subject to approval by the Board of Directors of Integrex Global Partners Corp.. The latest version of this policy will be published on the Company's website.
