- * The Washington-Wilkes Chamber of Commerce reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to accept or reject your application based on the event's family atmosphere, health and safety considerations site constraints, numbers of exhibitors, and other factors.
- * You are required to take care of your own trash, keep your area clean, and supply your own garbage bags. When vacating the premises, you must remove all trash from your location.
- * If you are unable to attend, you may not allow another exhibitor to take your space.
- *You must conduct yourselves at all times in a professional, courteous, safe and friendly manner and in a manner consistent with Mule Day's family atmosphere.

Set-Up:

- * You MUST unload your vehicle and promptly move it to the designated Vendor Parking area before setting up. Vehicles are not allowed on the event site after 8:30 am and must be moved to Vendor Parking by 8:30 am. Vehicles may not return to the event site until after 4:00 pm.
- * You must provide your own tent, tables, chairs, display racks, equipment, tools and any other materials needed. Tents must be weighted to withstand weather conditions

Responsibility:

The Washington-Wilkes Chamber of Commerce, the City of Washington, and Wilkes County are not responsible for theft, loss, injury, death, or damage to exhibitor, exhibitor's staff, exhibitor's merchandise or property during Mule Day or while setting up, participating in, or dismantling.
