

### **Contract Multipurpose Adhesive**





#### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Multi Lock Pro is a medium-solids, latex-based adhesive with good bond strength and rebond characteristics. Multi Lock Pro dries to a flexible, rubbery bond line with good tack. Light in color, Multi Lock Pro is a good choice for the installation of basic carpet types and felt-backed vinyl sheet flooring in residential and light commercial applications. Multi Lock Pro is ideally suited for flooring installations that may need removal within 2 to 3 years, such as installations in rental properties as well as main-street commercial and retail outlets.

- For interior residential applications (rental apartments and condominiums)
- For interior light commercial applications (general office areas, hotel rooms and small retail stores)

### **SUBSTRATE REQUIREMENTS**

All substrates must be properly prepared, structurally sound, dry, solid and stable. The substrate should be clean and free of dust, dirt, oil, grease, paint, curing agents, concrete sealers, loosely bonded toppings, loose particles, old adhesive residues, and any other substance or condition that may prevent or reduce adhesion. All surfaces must be level, even, flat and smooth. Consult

### SUITABLE SUBSTRATES (properly prepared)

- Exterior-grade plywood, Group 1, CC type
- Other approved wood underlayments (per flooring manufacturer recommendations)
- Concrete and cement terrazzo
- Cement-based self-leveling underlayments and patching compounds
- Embossing levelers applied over existing and fully bonded ceramic tile and sheet vinyl
- A single layer of fully bonded vinyl composition tile (VCT)
- Primed gypsum underlayments that meet the ASTM F2419 requirements for compressive strength

Consult Technical Services for installation recommendations regarding substrates and conditions not listed.

### **LIMITATIONS**

- Do not install over any substrates containing asbestos.
- For interior installations only
- Do not use to install nonporous floor coverings over nonporous surfaces.
- Do not use to install solid vinyl flooring products.
- Do not use to install vinyl-backed carpet products.
- Do not apply over any adhesive residues, including cutback adhesive.
- Do not install when the moisture vapor emission rate (MVER) exceeds 3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (1,36 kg per 92,9 m²) per 24 hours, when using the anhydrous calcium chloride test (ASTM F1869).
- Do not install when the relative humidity (RH) of the concrete slab exceeds 80% (ASTM F2170).
- Do not install in areas with known hydrostatic moisture problems.



- Use only when the substrate temperature is between 50°F and 90°F (10°C and 32°C), and when the ambient RH is between 20% and 80%.
- Do not install unless the temperature of the prepared concrete slab is at least 5 degrees Fahrenheit (2,8 degrees Celsius) above the dew point to avoid condensation.

#### MIXING

Consult the Safety Data Sheet for safe-handling instructions.

• Ready to use; no mixing is necessary.

### **APPLICATION**

- 1. Read all installation instructions thoroughly before installation.
- Select the appropriate notched trowel (see the "Approximate Coverage" chart).
- Spread adhesive evenly over the subfloor, keeping the trowel at a 45-degree angle to the subfloor.
- 4. For <u>porous</u> substrates, allow adhesive to flash 0 to 15 minutes before installing flooring; install the flooring material into the adhesive while it is still wet. Over <u>nonporous</u> substrates, allow 20 minutes of drying time for the adhesive to tack up before placing flooring material.
- 5. Install flooring per the flooring manufacturer's instructions.
  - For <u>felt-backed vinyl sheet flooring</u> installations: Do not apply more adhesive than can be installed within 15 to 35 minutes.
  - For <u>carpet</u> installations: Do not apply more adhesive than can be installed within 30 to 45 minutes.
- 6. Periodically confirm the adhesive transfer to the backing by lifting the flooring material.
- 7. Roll the flooring immediately with the recommended-weight roller across the width and length of the flooring surface.

### **CLEANUP**

- Promptly clean any adhesive smudges from the flooring material's surface with water while the adhesive is still fresh/wet.
- Clean tools with water while the adhesive is still fresh/wet.
- Clean with mineral spirits once the adhesive has dried. Use caution with mineral spirits, which may be harmful to some materials.

### **PROTECTION**

- Protect from light traffic for 24 hours and from heavy traffic for 72 hours.
- Protect containers from freezing in transit and storage. Provide for heated storage on site and deliver all materials at least 24 hours before work begins.
